RE: LSA Document #15-283 – Amends 511 IAC to establish criteria or procedures, or both, regarding the state certificate of biliteracy.

On behalf of the Indiana State Board of Education, I am submitting this notice to the Publisher of the Indiana Register and Indiana Administrative Code in compliance with <u>IC 4-22-2-25</u>, which requires that a notice be sent to the Publisher if a rule will not be approved or deemed approved by the Governor within one year of publication of the Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule. This notice is to be submitted to the Publisher before the two hundred fiftieth day following the publication of the Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule.

The Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule was published in the Indiana Register on August 26, 2015 (DIN: 20150826-IR-511150283NIA).

Due to extended deliberations involving stakeholders and experts, the Board may not be able to complete the rulemaking process by August 26, 2016. Approval or deemed approval by the Governor is expected not later than December 31, 2017.

This notice is being submitted in a timely manner. March 29, 2016, is the two hundred sixteenth day after publication of the Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule.
