OVERVIEW: Amends <u>405 IAC 5-24-2</u> to add the definition "usual and customary charge" as used in <u>405 IAC</u> <u>5-24</u> to provide additional clarity regarding the calculation of the provider's "usual and customary charge" for a covered drug. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher. Statutory authority: <u>IC 12-15-1-10</u>; <u>IC 12-15-1-15</u>; <u>IC 12-15-13-7.2</u>; <u>IC 12-15-21-2</u>; <u>IC 12-15-21-3</u>.
