Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule

LSA Document #16-219

Under [IC 4-22-2-23](#), the Law Enforcement Training Board intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends [250 IAC 2-7-1](#) to include reserve police officers in mandatory in-service training requirements and to modify "year" to "calendar year". Amends [250 IAC 2-7-4](#) to permit the Law Enforcement Training Board to inquire as to the reasons for a reserve police officer's failure to meet annual in-service training requirements and to suspend an officer's police powers until training requirements are met. Amends [250 IAC 2-8-1](#) regarding maintenance of in-service training records. Questions and comments may be addressed to the Small Business Regulatory Coordinator for this rule.
