Notice of Changes in Methods and Standards for Medicaid Payments for Home Health Agencies

In accordance with public notice requirements of 42 CFR 447.205, the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) publishes this notice of proposed changes to the reimbursement methodology for Medicaid services provided by enrolled home health agencies.

The FSSA-OMPP proposes to hold the rates for home health services that were effective for the annual period beginning July 1, 2015, unchanged through June 30, 2017. This change is necessary to ensure continuity of member access to home health services.

It is estimated that the Medicaid payment increase of these changes will be approximately \$3.9 million for FFY 2016 (federal share of \$2.6 million and state share of \$1.3 million) and \$11.7 million for FFY 2017 (federal share of \$7.8 million and state share of \$3.9 million).
