Notice of Public Hearing

Under [IC 4-22-2-24](#), notice is hereby given that on August 4, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., at the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Conference Center Room 19, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Office of the Secretary of Family and Social Services – Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning will hold a public hearing on a proposed rule amending [405 IAC 1-16](#) to modify the Medicaid reimbursement rule for covered hospice services to be consistent with federal regulations and also to make minor language revisions.

Pursuant to [IC 4-22-2-24](#)(d)(3), the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) – Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) has determined that these changes are necessary due to federal changes to Medicare hospice payment rates, which is the rate upon which Indiana's hospice payments are based. FSSA-OMPP's proposed rule will not impose any new compliance costs on any regulated entity.

All parties interested in the proposed rule are invited to attend the public hearing and to offer public comments.
