Under <u>IC 4-22-2-24</u>, notice is hereby given that on August 16, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., at the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Conference Center Room 2, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Office of the Secretary of Family and Social Services – Division of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHA) will hold a public hearing on a proposed rule adding <u>440 IAC 10-2-3</u> to set forth the manner in which the DMHA will determine whether there is a need for a new opioid treatment program in a proposed program location's geographic area.

Pursuant to <u>IC 4-22-2-24</u>(d)(3), the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) – DMHA has determined that these changes are necessary pursuant to <u>IC 12-23-18-5.5</u>(e).
