## Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule

Under <u>IC 4-22-2-23</u>, the Office of the Secretary of Family and Social Services intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

**OVERVIEW:** Amends <u>405 IAC 5-24-2</u> to update the definition of "pharmacy services". Amends <u>405 IAC 5-24-4</u> to update the reimbursement methodology for legend drugs. Amends <u>405 IAC 5-24-5</u> to remove insulin from the calculation of reimbursement for nonlegend drugs. Amends <u>405 IAC 5-24-6</u> to update terminology and modify the calculation of the Medicaid professional dispensing fee. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher. Statutory authority: <u>IC 12-15-1-10</u>; <u>IC 12-15-1-15</u>; <u>IC 12-15-21-2</u>.
