Temporarily amends <u>326 IAC 1-4-16</u> to add the federal redesignation for Lawrenceburg Township in Dearborn County to attainment of the 2008 8-hour ozone standard. Statutory authority: <u>IC 13-14-8-1</u>. Effective April 13, 2017.

SECTION 1. (a) This SECTION supersedes 326 IAC 1-4-16.

PM <sub>2.5</sub>	Unclassifiable or attainment effective December 13, 2009, for the 24-hour PM <sub>2.5</sub> standard.
PM <sub>10</sub>	Unclassifiable effective November 15, 1990.
NO <sub>2</sub>	Cannot be classified or better than national standards.
Pb	Unclassifiable or attainment effective December 31, 2011.
<sup>1</sup> Unclassifiable or attainment effective October 18, 2000, for the 1-hour ozone standard which was revoked effective June 15, 2005.
