IC 4-22-2.1-5 Statement Concerning Rules Affecting Small Businesses

The proposed rule will not impose requirements or costs on small businesses under <u>IC 4-22-2.1-5</u>. This rule will simply restrict the distribution and use of an estimated fewer than fifty agricultural herbicides containing dicamba to pesticide users and distributors already credentialed and regulated by the State Chemist. Because the requirements in this rule will apply only to higher concentration agricultural weed control products but not lower concentration turf weed control products, and because there are currently numerous alternative herbicides that could be used in place of dicamba-containing products, neither pesticide dealers and distributors nor pesticide applicators or application businesses will be impacted fiscally.
