Notice of Changes in Methods and Standards for Medicaid Payments for Home Health Agencies

In accordance with public notice requirements of 42 CFR 447.205, the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) publishes this notice of proposed changes to the cost reporting requirements of enrolled home health agencies (HHA).

OMPP proposes to remove the requirement for HHAs to complete and submit cost reports effective October 1, 2017. Additionally, language is changed to bring the State Plan into compliance with 42 CFR 440.70 by not restricting HHA services to only members who are homebound.

These changes have no impact on reimbursement rates and therefore there is no fiscal impact.
