TITLE 513 COMMISSION ON SECLUSION AND RESTRAINT IN SCHOOLS

Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule

LSA Document #18-63

Under <u>IC 4-22-2-23</u>, the Commission on Seclusion and Restraint in Schools intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends 513 IAC to add a preamble to the rule. Amends <u>513 IAC 1-1-12</u> to modify definition of "physical restraint". Amends <u>513 IAC 1-1-18</u> to modify definition of "school employee". Adds <u>513 IAC 1-1-18.5</u> to add a definition for "school resource officer". Amends <u>513 IAC 1-1-20</u> to modify definition of "staff". Amends <u>513 IAC 1-2-5</u> to clarify when a bus harness or other safety equipment may be used to restrain a student when transporting. Amends <u>513 IAC 1-2-6</u> and <u>513 IAC 1-2-7</u> to clarify those provisions and to add the requirement to report the use of seclusion or restraint by school resource officers. Amends <u>513 IAC 1-2-8</u> to clarify provisions, add the requirement to report the use of seclusion or restraint by school resource officers, and to add provisions requiring the Indiana department of education to review a sampling of incident reports by schools. Amends <u>513 IAC 1-2-11</u> to add provisions requiring the department to receive, on behalf of the commission, reports from the public regarding school restraint and seclusion plans. Statutory authority: <u>IC 20-20-40</u>.
