
TITLE 511 INDIANA STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

60 Day Requirement ([IC 4-22-2-19](#))

On behalf of the Indiana State Board of Education (SBOE), I am submitting this notice in compliance with [IC 4-22-2-19](#), which requires an agency to begin the rulemaking process not later than 60 days after the effective date of the statute that authorizes the rule, unless a notice is filed with the Publisher that includes the reasons for the noncompliance.

The statutory authority for rulemaking that allows the SBOE to amend [511 IAC 6.2](#) concerning the assessment of school and school corporation growth and performance is [IC 20-19-2-8](#) and [IC 20-31-10-1](#).

The SBOE was unable to begin the rulemaking process within 60 days of the authorizing statute's effective date due to the fact that the need to amend [511 IAC 6.2-10](#) and replace it with [511 IAC 6.2-11](#) was recently identified by the Board.

The SBOE initiated the rulemaking process by publishing its Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule in the Indiana Register on January 10, 2018 (DIN: [20180110-IR-511180007NIA](#)).
