60 Day Requirement (IC 4-22-2-19) LSA Document #18-7

On behalf of the Indiana State Board of Education (SBOE), I am submitting this notice in compliance with LC 4-22-2-19, which requires an agency to begin the rulemaking process not later than 60 days after the effective date of the statute that authorizes the rule, unless a notice is filed with the Publisher that includes the reasons for the noncompliance.

The statutory authority for rulemaking that allows the SBOE to amend <u>511 IAC 6.2</u> concerning the assessment of school and school corporation growth and performance is <u>IC 20-19-2-8</u> and <u>IC 20-31-10-1</u>.

The SBOE was unable to begin the rulemaking process within 60 days of the authorizing statute's effective date due to the fact that the need to amend <u>511 IAC 6.2-10</u> and replace it with <u>511 IAC 6.2-11</u> was recently identified by the Board.

The SBOE initiated the rulemaking process by publishing its Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule in the Indiana Register on January 10, 2018 (DIN: 20180110-IR-511180007NIA).
