## Notice of Changes in Methods and Standards for Medicaid Payments for Inpatient Hospital Services

In accordance with public notice requirements established at 42 CFR 447.205 and Section 1902(a)(13)(A) of the Social Security Act, the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration, Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) publishes this notice of proposed changes to methods and standards governing reimbursement policy for Medicaid-enrolled hospitals. This public notice period will run from May 16, 2018, to June 18, 2018.

OMPP proposes to revise the inpatient hospital transfer reimbursement policy to apply the DRG daily rate payment methodology to the transferring and transferee hospital. This change shall be effective October 1, 2018.

OMPP is making the change in order to more equitably reimburse the transferring hospital and the transferee hospital for inpatient transfer cases. It is estimated that the fiscal impact of these changes will be an annual decrease in state and federal expenditures of approximately \$0.85 million for Federal Fiscal Years (FFYs) 2019 and 2020 (federal share of \$0.56 million and state share of \$0.29 million).
