60 Day Requirement (IC 4-22-2-19) LSA Document #18-153

On behalf of the Indiana State Board of Education (Board), I am submitting this notice in compliance with LC 4-22-2-19, which requires an agency to begin the rulemaking process not later than 60 days after the effective date of the statutes that authorize the rule, unless a notice is filed with the Publisher that includes the reasons for the noncompliance.

The statutory authority for rulemaking that allows the Board to amend <u>511 IAC 7</u> concerning special education is <u>IC 20-19-2-8</u> and <u>IC 20-19-2-16</u>.

The Board was unable to begin the rulemaking process within 60 days of the authorizing statutes' effective dates due to the fact that the need to amend 511 IAC 7 was recently identified by the Board.

The Board initiated the rulemaking process by publishing its Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule in the Indiana Register on March 21, 2018 (DIN: <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/journal.org
