Emergency Rule
LSA Document #19-133(E)

DIGEST

Temporarily amends [326 IAC 1-4](#) to designate Clark and Floyd counties to nonattainment for the 2015 ozone standard. Statutory authority: [IC 13-14-8-1](#). *NOTE: The first extension of this emergency document, LSA Document #18-511(E), posted at [20181121-IR-326180511ERA](#), effective November 15, 2018, expired February 13, 2019. Effective February 14, 2019.*

SECTION 1. (a) This SECTION supersedes [326 IAC 1-4-11](#).

(b) The following attainment status designations are applicable to Clark County:

NO ₂	Unclassifiable or attainment effective January 29, 2012, for the 2010 NO ₂ standard.
