OVERVIEW: Amends <u>405 IAC 1-8-3</u> to extend through June 30, 2021, the three percent rate reduction for covered outpatient hospital services that is currently set to expire on June 30, 2019. Amends <u>405 IAC 1-10.5-6</u> to extend through June 30, 2021, the three percent rate reduction for covered inpatient hospital services that is currently set to expire on June 30, 2019. Amends <u>405 IAC 1-14.6-26</u> to extend through June 30, 2021, the three percent rate reduction for covered inpatient hospital services that is currently set to expire on June 30, 2019. Amends <u>405 IAC 1-14.6-26</u> to extend through June 30, 2021, the three percent rate reduction for covered nursing facilities that is currently set to expire on June 30, 2019.
