Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule

LSA Document #19-179

Under [IC 4-22-2-23](#), the Indiana State Board of Education intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends [511 IAC 6-7.1-1](#), [511 IAC 6-7.1-2](#), [511 IAC 6-7.1-4](#), [511 IAC 6-7.1-5](#), [511 IAC 6-7.1-6](#), and [511 IAC 6-7.1-7](#) and adds [511 IAC 6-7.1-10](#), concerning the Indiana diploma and alternatives to the mathematics credits requirements, to update the regulatory language and account for recently enacted legislation. Statutory authority: [IC 20-19-2-8](#); [IC 20-31-8-4.6](#); [IC 20-31-10-1](#).
