60 Day Requirement (IC 4-22-2-19)

On behalf of the Indiana State Board of Education (SBOE), I am submitting this notice in compliance with <u>IC 4-22-2-19</u>, which requires an agency to begin the rulemaking process not later than 60 days after the effective date of the statute that authorizes the rule, unless a notice is filed with the Publisher that includes the reasons for the noncompliance.

The statutory authority for rulemaking that allows the SBOE to amend <u>511 IAC 6-7.1</u> concerning the Indiana diploma and alternatives to the mathematics credits requirements is <u>IC 20-19-2-8</u>, <u>IC 20-31-8-4.6</u>, and <u>IC 20-31-10-1</u>.

The SBOE was unable to begin the rulemaking process within 60 days of the authorizing statute's effective date as the SBOE was working to comply with the requirements of Financial Management Circular #2015-1 before proceeding with the rulemaking process.

The SBOE initiated the rulemaking process by publishing its Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule in the Indiana Register on April 3, 2019 (DIN: <u>20190403-IR-511190179NIA</u>).
