## TITLE 511 INDIANA STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

One Year Requirement (IC 4-22-2-25)

RE: LSA Document #19-251 – Amends <u>511 IAC</u> to update the regulatory language, account for recently enacted legislation, and make numerous technical changes.

On behalf of the Indiana State Board of Education, I am submitting this notice to the Publisher of the Indiana Register pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Code in compliance with IC 4-22-2-25, which requires that a notice be sent to the Publisher if a rule will not be approved or deemed approved by the Governor within one year of publication of the Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule. This notice is to be submitted to the Publisher before the two hundred fiftieth day following the publication of the Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule.

The Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule was published in the Indiana Register on May 1, 2019 (DIN: 20190501-IR-511190251NIA).

Due to extended deliberations involving stakeholders and experts, the Board may not be able to complete the rulemaking process by May 1, 2020. Approval or deemed approval by the Governor is expected not later than August 31, 2020.

This notice is being submitted in a timely manner. December 19, 2019, is the two hundred and thirty-third day after publication of the Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule.
