Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule
LSA Document #20-72

Under [IC 4-22-2-23](#), the Indiana Board of Accountancy intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends [872 IAC 1-1-9.5](#) to eliminate the reference to testing windows. Amends [872 IAC 1-1-14](#) to eliminate the concept of testing windows. Amends [872 IAC 1-1-19](#) to remove prohibition against reexamination in testing windows. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.
