## TITLE 905 ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO COMMISSION

## Notice of Intent to Readopt

LSA Document #20-447

Readopts rules in anticipation of <u>IC 4-22-2.5-2</u>, providing that an administrative rule adopted under <u>IC 4-22-2</u> expires January 1 of the seventh year after the year in which the rule takes effect unless the rule contains an earlier expiration date. *NOTE: <u>IC 4-22-2.5-5</u> authorizes the Governor to postpone, by executive order, the expiration of rules for one year. Executive Order #19-03, issued December 23, 2019, and posted at <u>20200101-IR-GOV190689EOA</u>, postpones the expiration of <u>905 IAC 1-15.3-1</u> and <u>905 IAC 1-33.1-1</u> in this document until January 1, 2021. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.*
