Notice of Expansion of Telemedicine Services for Optical or Optometric Services

In accordance with public notice requirements established at 42 CFR 447.205, the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA), Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) publishes this notice of proposed changes to methods and standards governing service coverage for telemedicine services. The public notice period will run 09/23/2020-10/23/2020.

FSSA – OMPP proposes to modify health care coverage by including optometric services as reimbursable services available via telemedicine under Indiana Medicaid. These changes will be effective October 22, 2020.

OMPP is making these changes in order to comply with [IC 25-1-9.5-4](#), which lists licensed optometrists as prescribers authorized to deliver health care services via telemedicine. It is estimated that there will be no fiscal impact of these changes.
