using Access Code 180 307 0465 and Password zhSNA2ic3E3, the Indiana State Department of Health will hold a public hearing on proposed amendments to [410 IAC 16.2-3.1-25](#) to remove language allowing for unused portions of medications to be destroyed within seven days and replace with language to render nonretrievable within three days, to define rendering nonretrievable, and to add authorized storage containers as a method of disposing of unused portions of medications and proposed amendments to [410 IAC 16.2-5-6](#) to align with [410 IAC 16.2-3.1-25](#).

The Indiana State Department of Health has the authority to adopt this rule under [IC 16-28-1-7](#). This rule does impose an additional requirement that the unused portions of medication be destroyed within three days, rather than seven days. This rule provides for additional alternatives to rendering medications nonretrievable and does not impose any additional cost.
