Notice of Change in Nursing Facility Reimbursement Methodology

In accordance with public notice requirements established at [IC 12-15-14-8\(b\)](#), the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA), Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) publishes this notice of proposed changes to the reimbursement methodology for nursing facilities. The public comment period will be open from December 28, 2022, through January 27, 2023.

Nursing facilities are currently reimbursed at adjusted Medicare rates for Medicaid recipients that are covered through the Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) managed care program. Effective January 1, 2024, the nursing facility reimbursement rates for the HIP program will be set equal to the Medicaid fee-for-service program daily reimbursement rate for each participating facility. For calendar year 2024, the change in reimbursement is projected to represent a reduction in nursing facility reimbursement of \$11.3M which would equate to \$7.4M in federal savings and \$3.9M in state savings.
