**Notice of Changes in Statewide Methods and Standards for Setting Payments for Medicaid Enrolled Nonstate Operated Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities and Community Residential Facilities for the Developmentally Disabled**

In accordance with the public notice requirements of 42 CFR 447.205 and Section 1902(a)(13)(A) of the Social Security Act, the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA), Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) publishes this notice of proposed changes to the reimbursement methodology for nonstate operated intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICFs/IID) and community residential facilities for the developmentally disabled. This public notice will run from 03/01/2023 to 03/31/2023.

OMPP proposes to increase the rate paid to any ICF/IID that is licensed as a comprehensive rehabilitative management needs facility (CRMNF) to seven hundred three dollars and ten cents (\$703.10) per resident day. The proposed effective date is April 1, 2023.

It is estimated that the fiscal impact of this increase will increase federal and state expenditures approximately \$0.576 million for federal fiscal year 2023 (federal share \$0.399 million and state share \$0.176 million), \$1.151 million for federal fiscal year 2024 (federal share \$0.760 million and state share \$0.391 million), and \$1.151 million for federal fiscal year 2025 (federal share \$0.755 million and state share \$0.396 million).
