Notice of Changes in Statewide Uniform Preferred Drug List

In accordance with public notice requirements established at 42 CFR 430.20 and 42 CFR 447.205, the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA), Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) publishes this notice of proposed changes to the Indiana Health Coverage Programs prescription drug benefit preferred drug list (PDL) and subsequent supplemental rebate collections. The public notice period will run 03/15/2023 to 04/14/2023.

FSSA-OMPP proposes that managed care entities contracted with the state of Indiana follow a statewide uniform preferred drug list (SUPDL) for drugs listed in the classes on the fee-for-service (FFS) PDL. Following SUPDL, the state will amend its supplemental rebate agreements with drug manufacturers so that the state may collect supplemental rebates for utilization from both FFS and managed care outpatient drug claims. These changes will be effective July 5, 2023.
