

60 Day Requirement ([IC 4-22-2-19](#))

On behalf of the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), I am submitting this notice in compliance with [IC 4-22-2-19](#), which requires an agency to begin the rulemaking process for new rules not later than 60 days after the effective date of the statutes that authorize the rule, unless a notice is filed with the publisher that includes the reasons why rulemaking began more than 60 days after the effective date.

To comply with [IC 4-22-2-19\(b\)](#) and [IC 4-22-2-19\(c\)](#), DNR is asking for an extension on the carbon sequestration project.

DNR was unable to begin the rulemaking process within 60 days of the authorizing statute's effective date at this time with regard to the carbon sequestration project and needs time to conduct research and solicit industry input.
