SUMMARY OF FINDINGS UNDER IC 4-22-2.6-4

<u>IC 16-41-37.5</u> requires the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) to adopt rules under <u>IC 4-22-2</u> to establish an indoor air quality inspection, evaluation, and employee notification program to assist state agencies in improving indoor air quality. The rules ensure that indoor air quality in schools is safe for students and staff in the least restrictive manner possible. The rules do not include any fees, fines, or penalties. IDOH has received limited complaints or comments about schools not having adequate space above drop ceilings to have the required ducted returns. IDOH has prepared an interpretation to the rules that has helped schools achieve the best air quality under the circumstances.
