SUMMARY OF FINDINGS UNDER IC 4-22-2.6-4

<u>IC 16-21-6-9</u> requires the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) executive board to adopt rules under <u>IC 4-22-2</u> pertaining to financial reporting for hospitals. The rules do the aforementioned in the least restrictive manner possible. The sections of the rule that are being readopted do not include any fees, fines, or civil penalties. There have been no complaints or comments received from the public regarding these rules. IDOH will amend the rules to reflect statutory changes made since they were adopted, including 2023 amendments to <u>IC 16-21-6-3</u>. The rules are being readopted so that they will not expire before the amendments are completed.
