**Notice of Public Hearing**

Under [IC 4-22-2-24](#), notice is hereby given that on **February 22, 2024, at 11:00 a.m.**, at the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Room W064, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Medical Licensing Board of Indiana will hold a public hearing on a new proposed rule concerning convictions of concern. This rule implements the provisions of [IC 25-1-1.1-6](#) requiring every board, commission, or committee under [IC 25](#) to revise its licensing or certification requirements to explicitly list the convictions of concern that may disqualify an individual from receiving a license; to establish criteria to determine whether an applicant should be denied a license if the applicant has a conviction of concern; and to establish a procedure for an individual to receive a preapplication determination as to whether the individual's criminal history would preclude the individual from obtaining a license.

[IC 4-22-2-24](#)(d)(3) Justification Statement: There are no new costs for businesses. There is not expected to be any new change in requirements or costs for state or local government because of this rule amendment. There are no new compliance or administrative costs. There are minimal new enforcement requirements.
