## DIGEST

Temporarily adds rules concerning scratch-off game number 796. Effective January 10, 2006.

SECTION 1. The name of the scratch-off game is "Scratch-Off Game Number 796, Run The Table".
SECTION 2. Scratch-off tickets in scratch-off game number 796 shall sell for five dollars (\$5) per ticket.
SECTION 3. Play symbols: A scratch-off ticket in "Scratch-Off Ticket Game Number 796, Run the Table" shall contain thirty-three (33) play and prize spots with four (4) independent games labeled "GAME 1", "GAME 2", "GAME 3", and "GAME 4". GAME 1 includes nine (9) play spots and three (3) prize spots. There shall be a matrix of three (3) rows labeled "HAND 1", "HAND 2", and "HAND 3", respectively, and four (4) columns labeled "DEALER'S LOW CARD", "YOUR CARD", "DEALER'S HIGH CARD", and the right column shall be labeled "PRIZE". GAME 2 includes one (1) play spot. GAME 3 includes six (6) play spots and three (3) prize spots. There shall be matrix of three (3) rows labeled "HAND 1", "HAND 2", and "HAND 3", respectively, and three (3) columns labeled "YOUR CARD", "THEIR CARD", and the right column shall be labeled "PRIZE". GAME 4 includes six (6) play spots with three (3) prize spots included within, which shall be arranged in pairs representing numbers and prize amounts directly under three (3) columns labeled "HAND 1", "HAND 2", and "HAND 3". Also in GAME 4 is a small box located independently in the bottom portion of the scratch-off ticket including two (2) play spots under heading labeled "DEALER'S HAND". The play symbol captions that appear in scratch-off game number 796 shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:

SECTION 4. Prize symbols: GAME 1 and GAME 3 shall contain three (3) prize spots each, GAME 2 does not contain a prize spot, and GAME 4 shall contain three (3) prize spots within the play spot. Prize symbol captions correspond with and verify each of the prize symbols as follows:

SECTION 5. Retailer validation codes: The retailer
validation code verifies instant winners of " $\$ 5 "$, " $\$ 10 "$, " $\$ 15 "$, " $\$ 20 ", " \$ 40 ", " \$ 50 ", " \$ 100 "$, and " $\$ 500 "$. The retailer validation code which corresponds with and verifies each of these winners is as follows:

SECTION 6. How to win: (a) A prize winner in "Scratch-Off Game Number 796, Run the Table" is determined by removing the entire scratch-off material from the play area on the front of the ticket to reveal twenty-four (24) play spots and nine (9) prize spots in four (4) independent games labeled "GAME 1", "GAME 2", "GAME 3", and "GAME 4". Neither the retailer validation code (nor any portion thereof), the pack-ticket number (or any portion thereof), nor the validation number (or any portion thereof) are play symbols or prize symbols and are not usable or playable as such.
(b) In GAME 1, if the "YOUR CARD" number is greater than the "DEALER'S LOW CARD" number and less than the "DEALER'S HIGH CARD" number within a HAND, the holder is entitled to the prize shown for that HAND. If the "YOUR CARD" is a ${ }^{\text {ål }}$ (crown symbol), the holder is entitled to win DOUBLE the prize for that HAND.
(c) In GAME 2, if the " 21 " symbol is revealed, the holder is entitled to win fifty dollars (\$50).
(d) In GAME 3, if the "YOUR CARD" number is greater than the "THEIR CARD" number within each HAND, the holder
 prize for that HAND. Aces are high.
(e) In GAME 4, if the total of any single HAND is greater than the total of the "DEALER'S HAND", the holder is entitled to win the prize shown for that HAND. If the total of any single HAND equals " 21 ", the holder is entitled to win DOUBLE the prize for that HAND. Symbols of a Jack, Queen, and King " eleven (11).
