



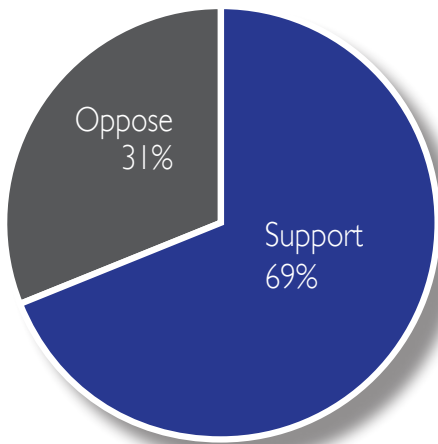

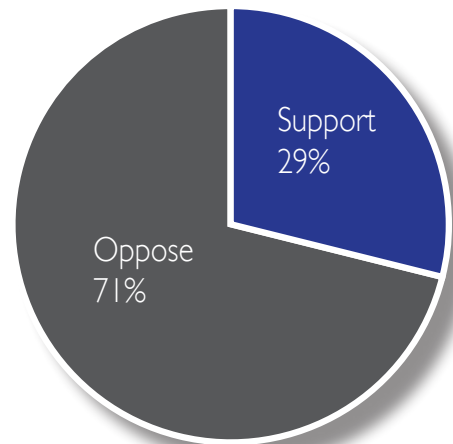


## 2012 Legislative Survey Results

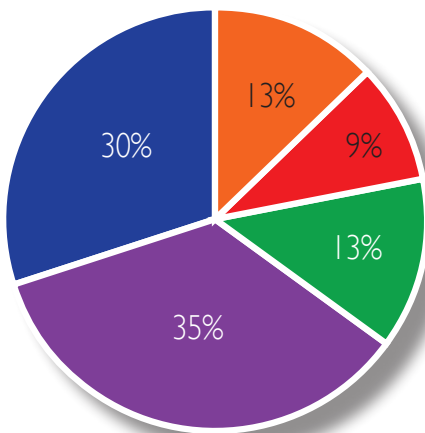


2. Commonly referred to as school vouchers, do you support or oppose the use of taxpayer dollars to send some children to private schools at the expense of local public schools?



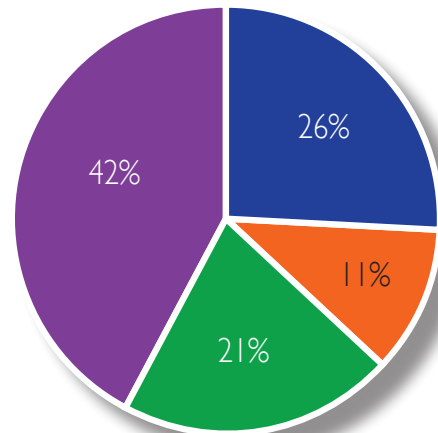
3. How would you like to see voter access improved?

- None of the above.



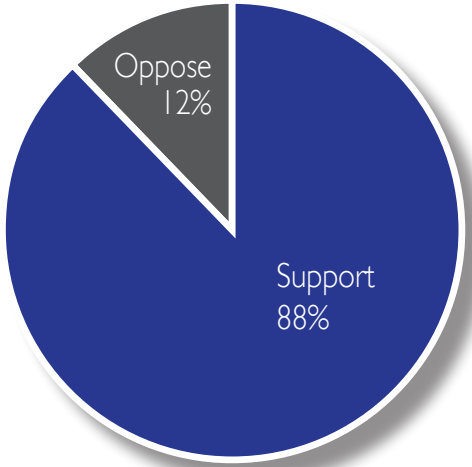
4. Choose the option that most closely reflects your position on Indiana's marijuana policies:

- Marijuana should be treated like alcohol, with restricted sales and excise tax.

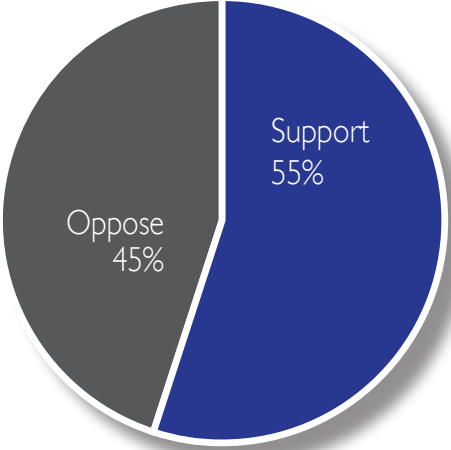

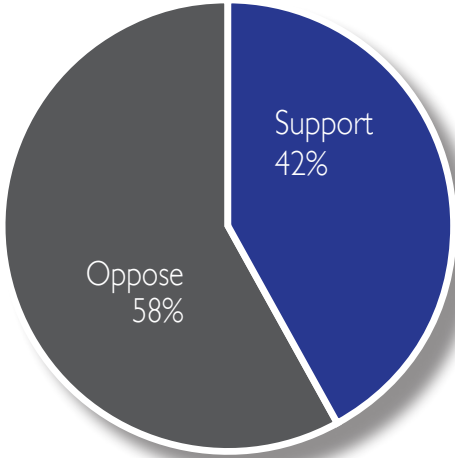
5. Would you support or oppose more revenue being directed to the maintenance of local roads instead of the construction of new state highways?



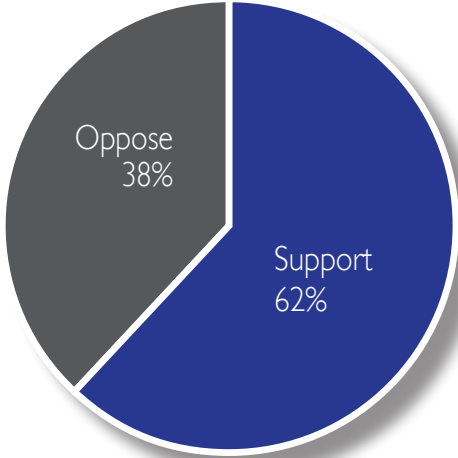

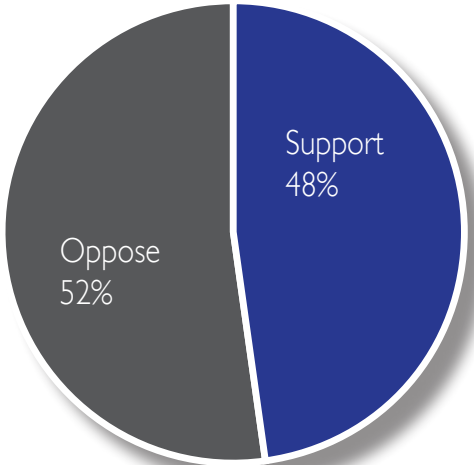

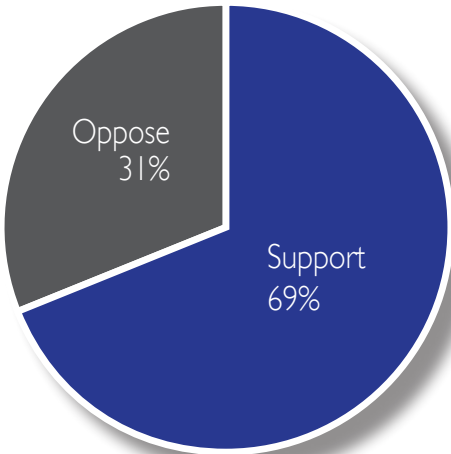
10. Do you support or oppose a statewide ban on smoking in public places?
