



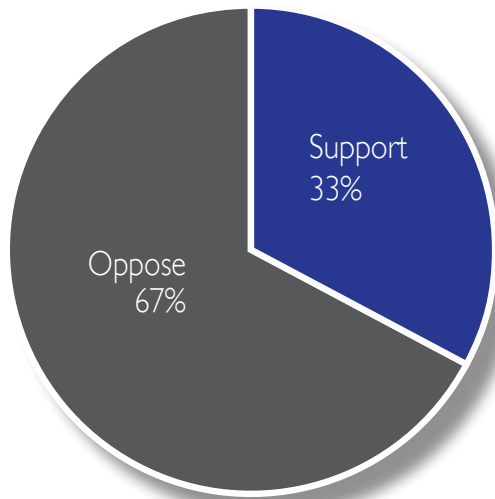

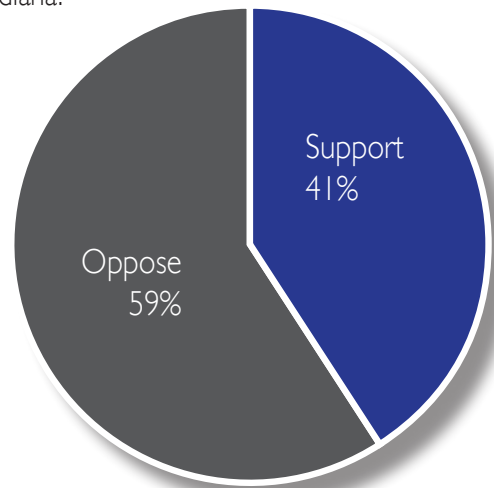


2012 Legislative Survey Results

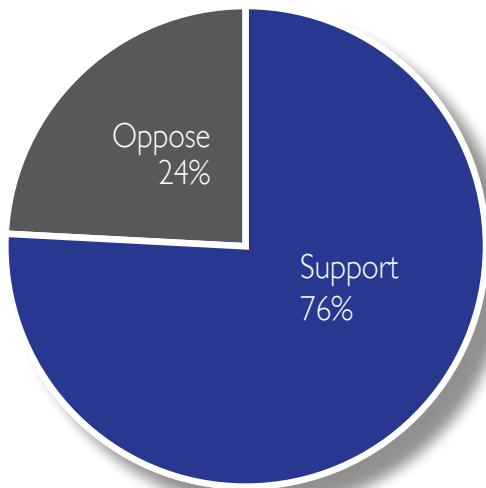
1. Commonly referred to as school vouchers, do you support or oppose the use of taxpayer dollars to send some children to private schools at the expense of local public schools?



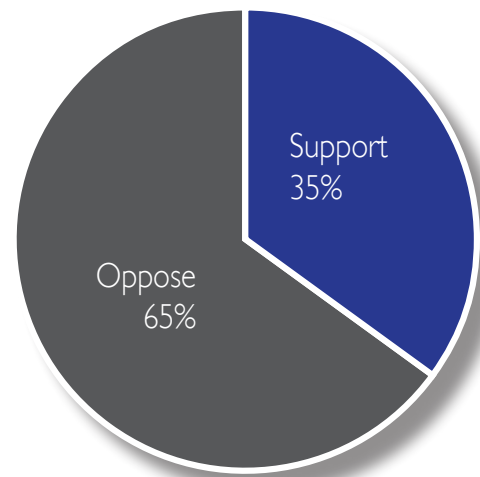

3. Do you support or oppose a statewide ban on smoking in public places?

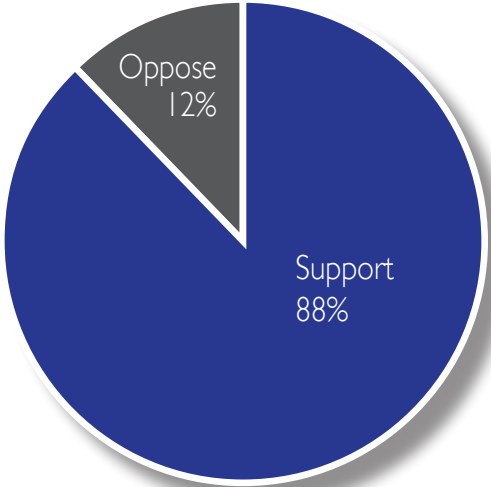

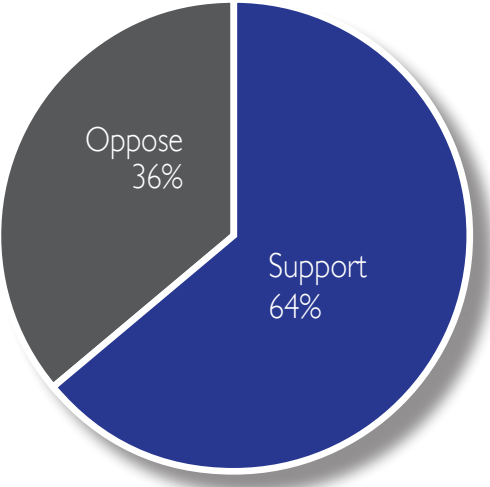

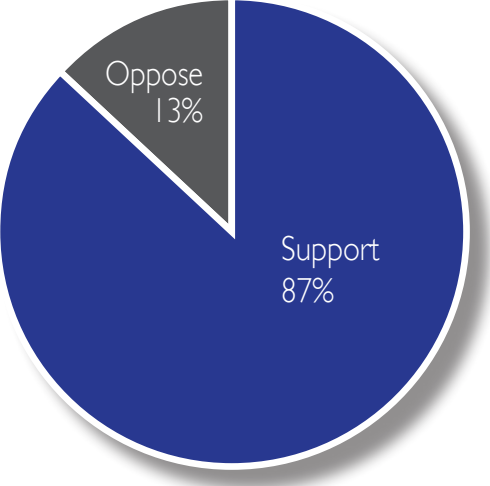
5. Would you support or oppose more revenue being directed to the maintenance of local roads instead of the construction of new state highways?



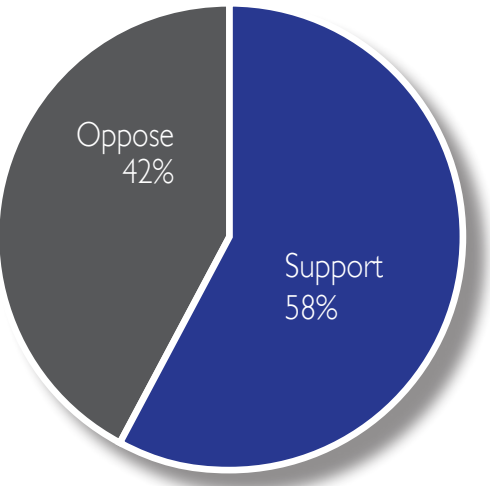

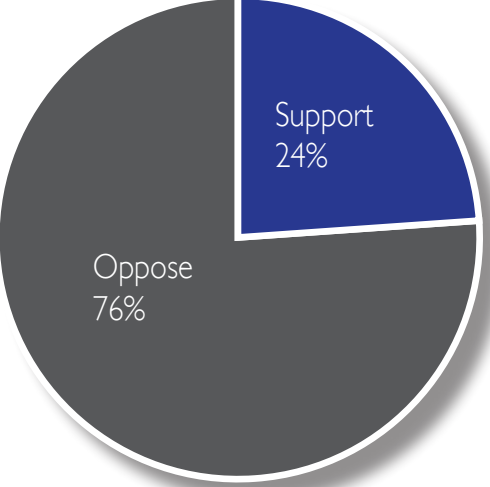
9. Do you support or oppose state regulators having more control over when a utility increases their rates and by how much on consumers?



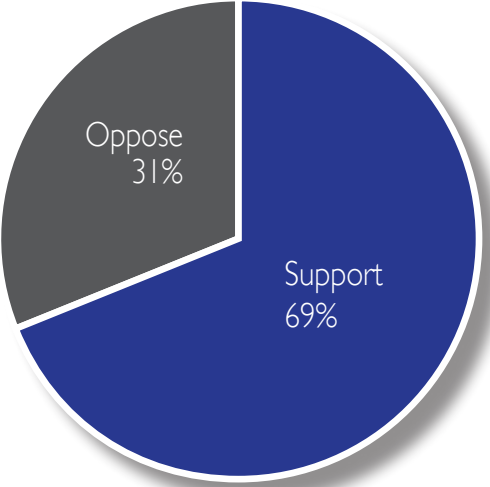

7. Do you support or oppose the decision to reduce the overall corporate income tax instead of targeting a reduced rate for small businesses or individual taxpayers?

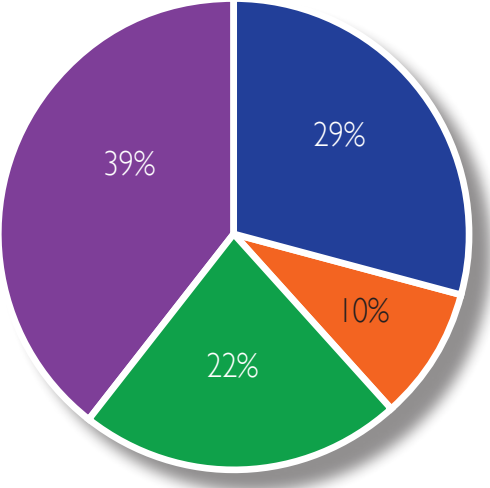


8. Do you support or oppose the retail sale of alcohol on Sundays?
