

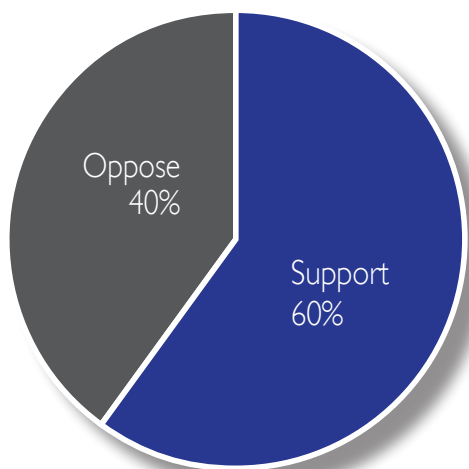

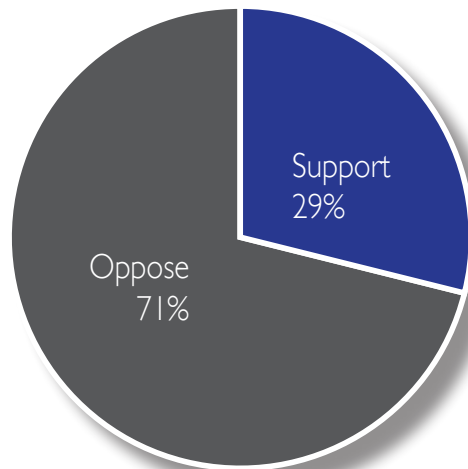


2012 Legislative Survey Results

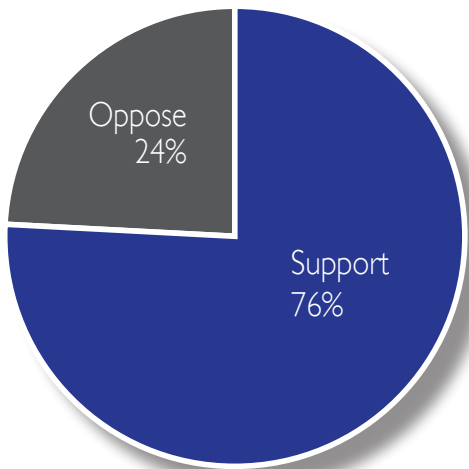
