



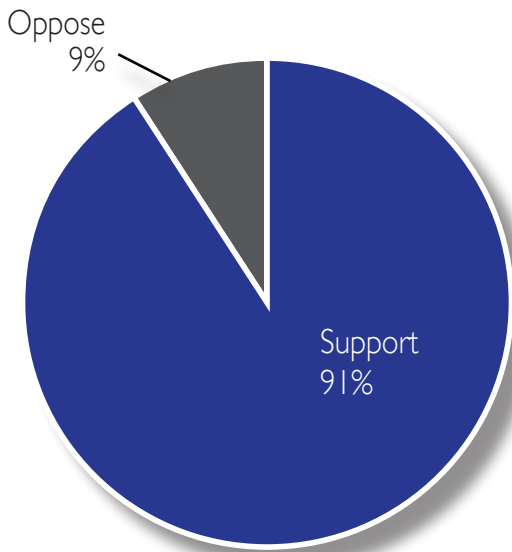

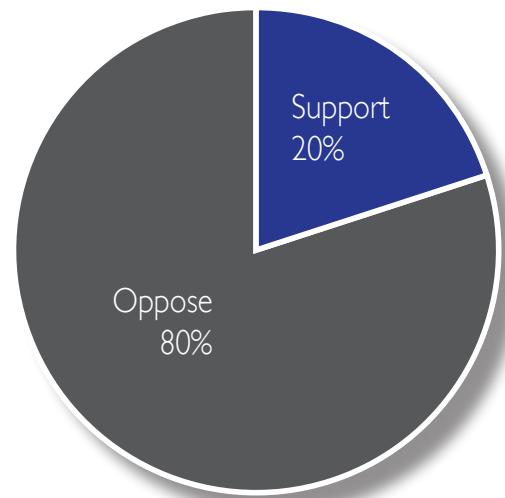


## 2012 Legislative Survey Results

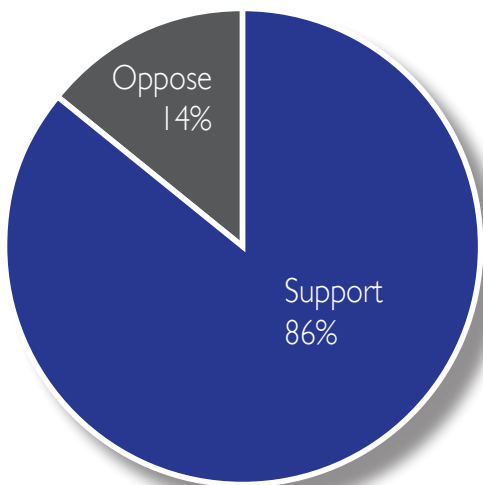
1. Would you support or oppose more revenue being directed to the maintenance of local roads instead of the construction of new state highways?



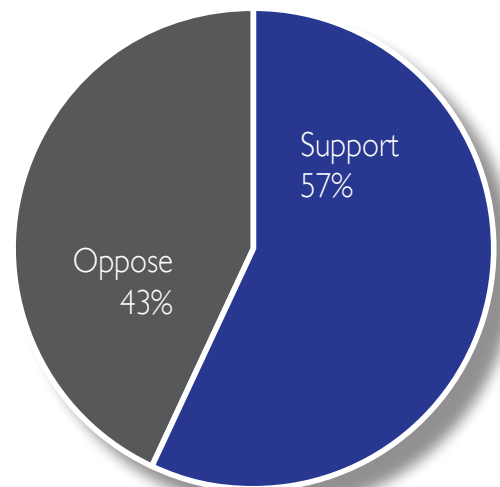
2. Do you support or oppose state government selling or leasing public assets for a short-term financial gain even if the long-term gain goes to a private company?



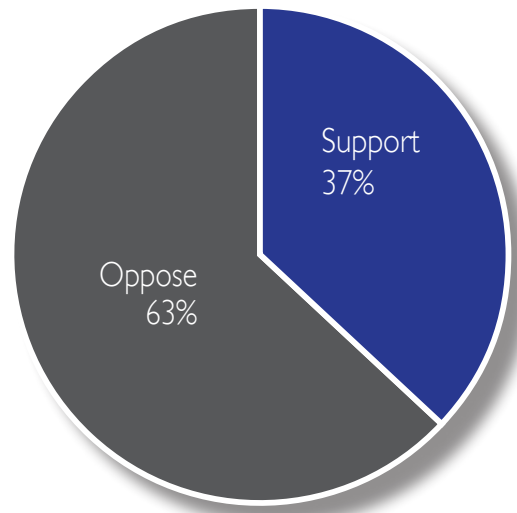
3. Do you support or oppose requiring all eligible candidates for municipal election to appear on a ballot, even if a race is uncontested?



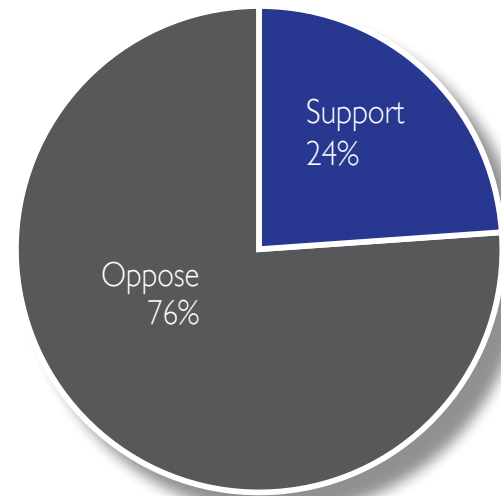

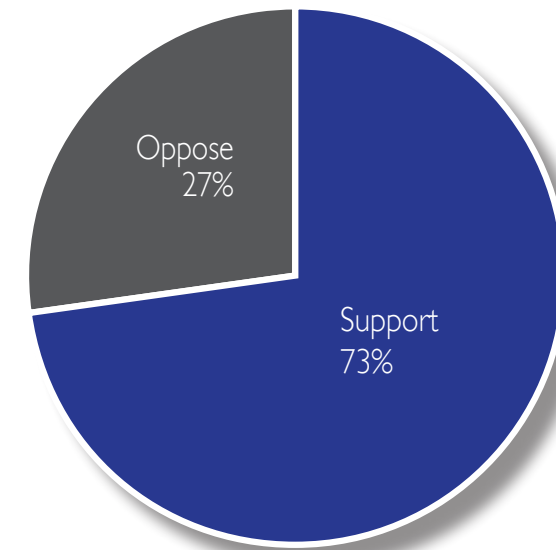

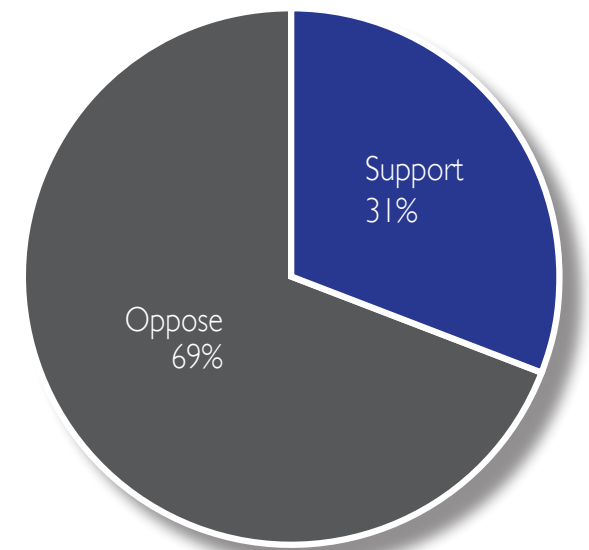
6. Do you support or oppose the decision to reduce the corporate income tax at a time when the state is also cutting services to the elderly, disabled, and children in need?



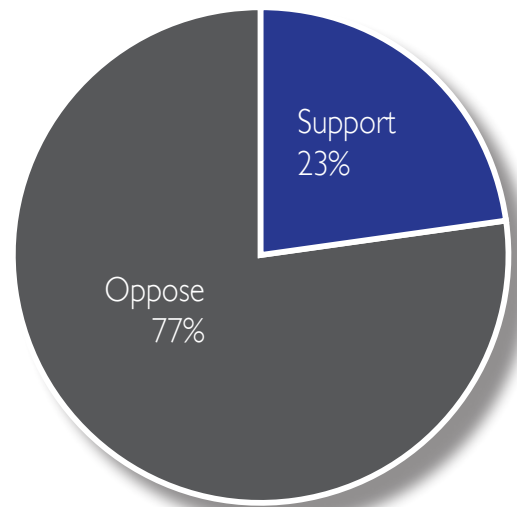

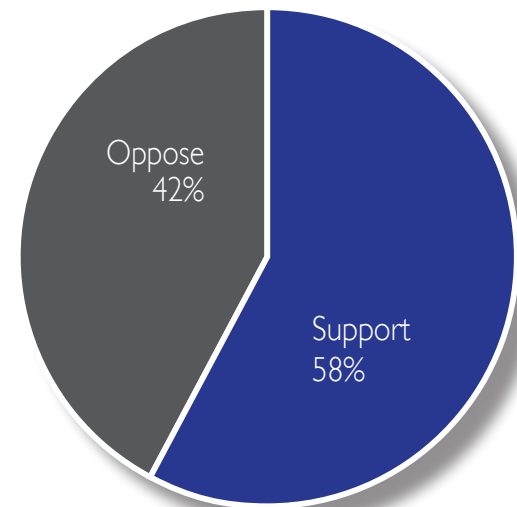
10. Commonly referred to as school vouchers, do you support or oppose the use of taxpayer dollars to send some children to private schools at the expense of local public schools?



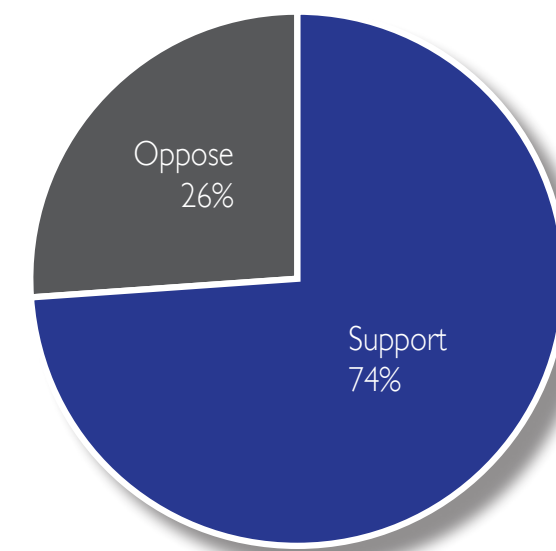
7. Do you support or oppose the decision to reduce the overall corporate income tax instead of targeting a reduced rate for small businesses or individual taxpayers?
