A retired National City Bank officer, Mrvan served 10 years on the Hammond City Council, including several years as the council's president, before being elected to the State Senate in 1978.

Mrvan currently serves as the ranking Democrat on the Senate's Ethics Committee, and the Insurance & Financial Institutions Committee. He is

also a member of the Commerce & Economic Development and Education & Career Development standing committees as well as the Financial Institutions Subcommittee. In addition, Mrvan is a member of the Pension Management Oversight Commission.

Mrvan has also been appointed to serve on the Communications, Financial Services and Interstate Commerce Committee and the Human Services and Welfare Committee of the National Conference of State Legislatures, a bipartisan organization that serves the legislators and staffs of the nation's 50 states, its commonwealths and territories. In 2011, he received the Small Business Champion Award from the Indiana Chamber of Commerce, which recognizes legislators who support efforts for small business advocacy and growth. Mrvan is also involved in the Lakeshore Chamber of Commerce, America Legion and Knights of Columbus.

A veteran of the U.S. Air Force, Mrvan attended Indiana University and the American Institute of Banking. He and his wife, Jean, reside in Hammond and have three adult children.
