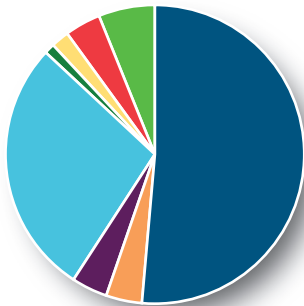

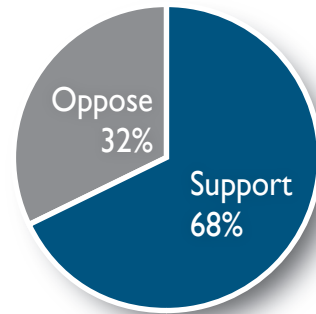
## 2011 Legislative Survey Results

1. This year the General Assembly will create a new two-year state budget. Please choose one of the following areas that you believe to be the top spending priority for the state:

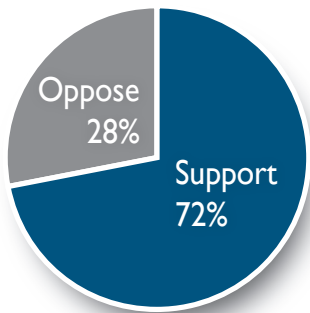
- 52% K-12 Education

- 1% Corrections



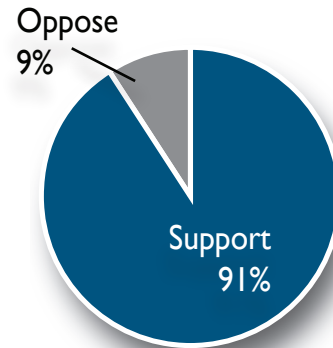
2. Do you support or oppose the retail sale of alcohol on Sundays?



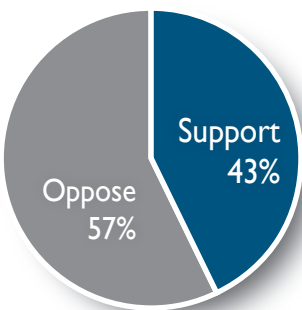
3. Do you support or oppose a statewide ban on smoking in public places?



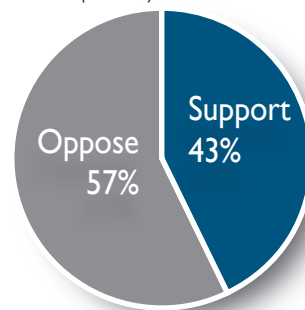
4. Do you support or oppose a ban on texting while driving for all drivers?



5. Commonly referred to as school vouchers, do you support or oppose allowing parents to use public money to send their children to private schools?







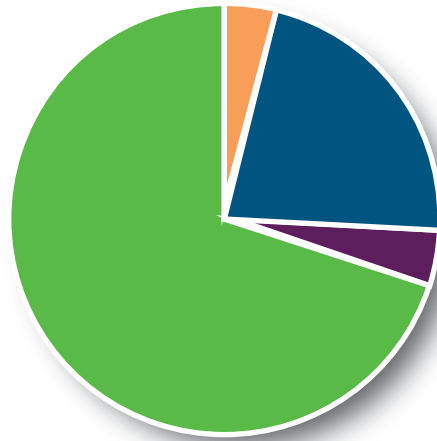
