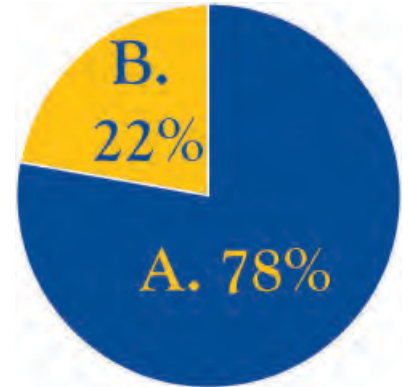

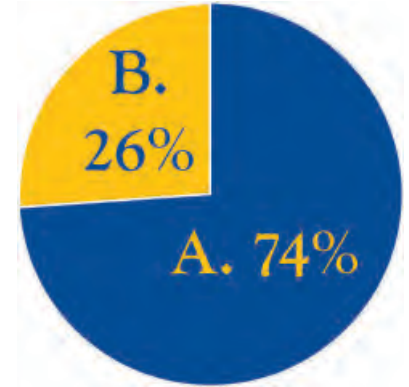
1. Would you support or oppose a bill to require a bipartisan study of best economic development practices used by other states in attracting, retaining and expanding business investment and job creation?

A. Support B. Oppose



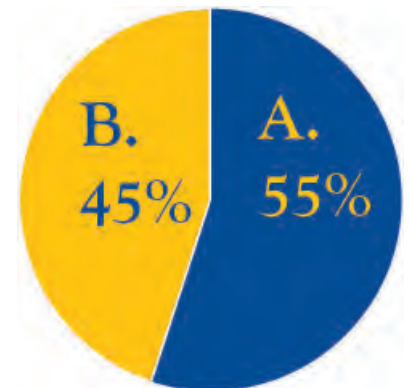

A. Support B. Oppose



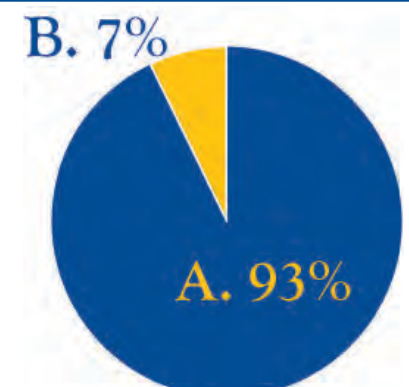
3. Would you support or oppose a bill that delays by one additional year new unemployment insurance premiums paid by Indiana businesses?

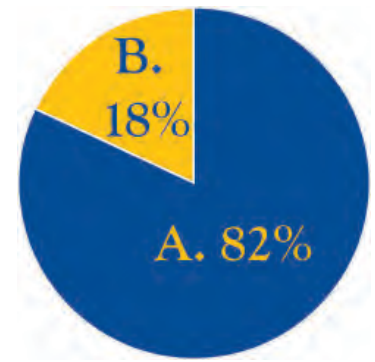
4. Would you support or oppose a bill that requires a one-year cooling off period before former legislators could professionally lobby state lawmakers?

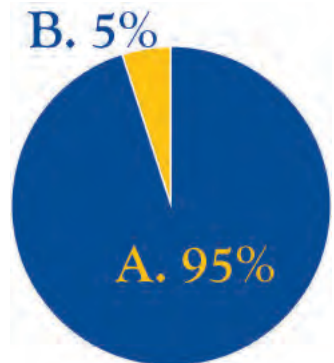
5. Would you support or oppose a bill requiring university officials who lobby legislators to meet the same registration and reporting requirements as other paid lobbyists?

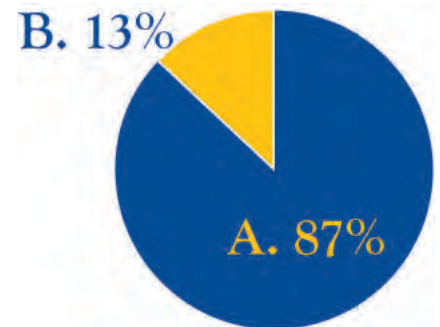
6. Would you support or oppose a bill further limiting and better defining gifts, meals and entertainment provided to legislators by lobbyists?

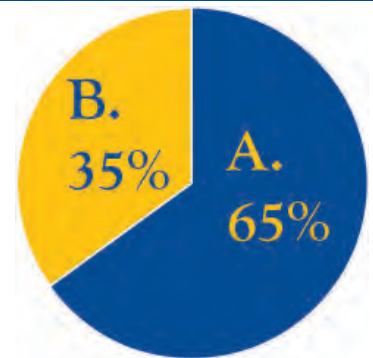
7. Would you support or oppose a bill that would establish more extensive statutory guidelines for drawing legislative and congressional districts?
