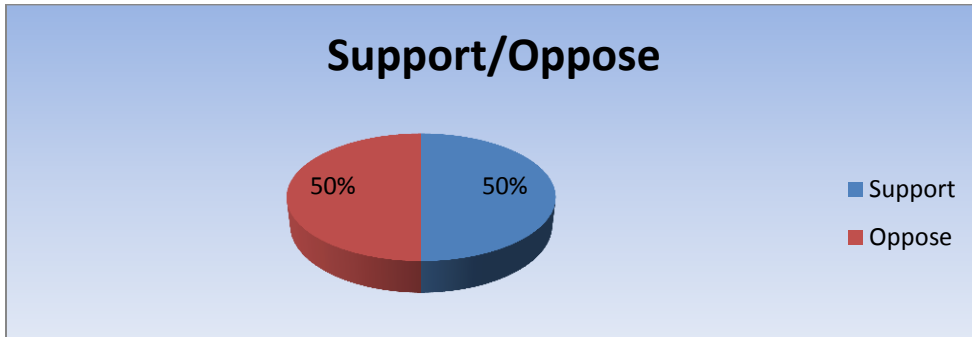


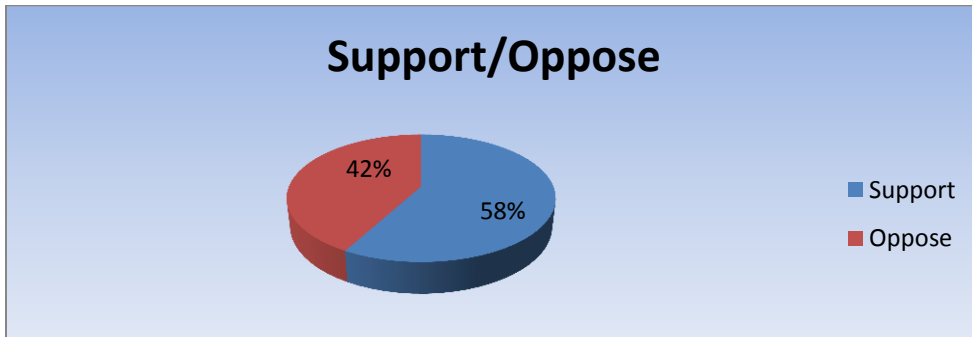

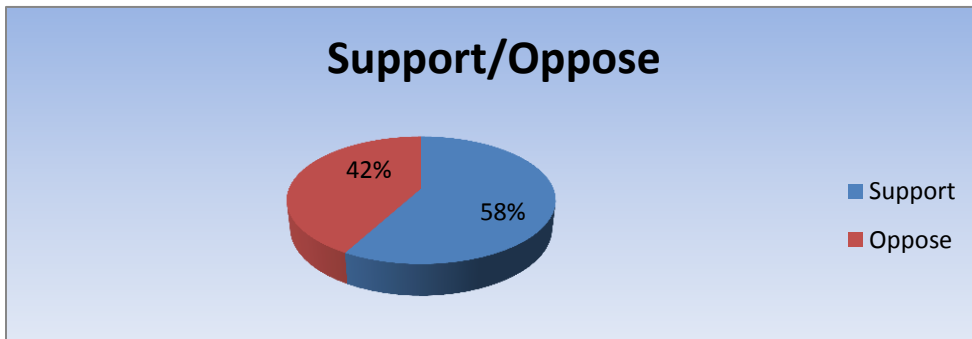
1. Would you support or oppose changing Indiana law to make employee contributions to unions voluntary, rather than mandatory?



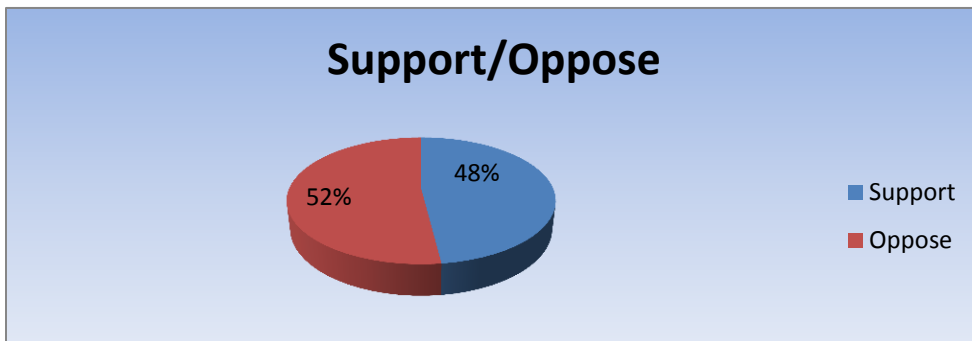
2. Would you support or oppose prohibiting smoking statewide in public places?



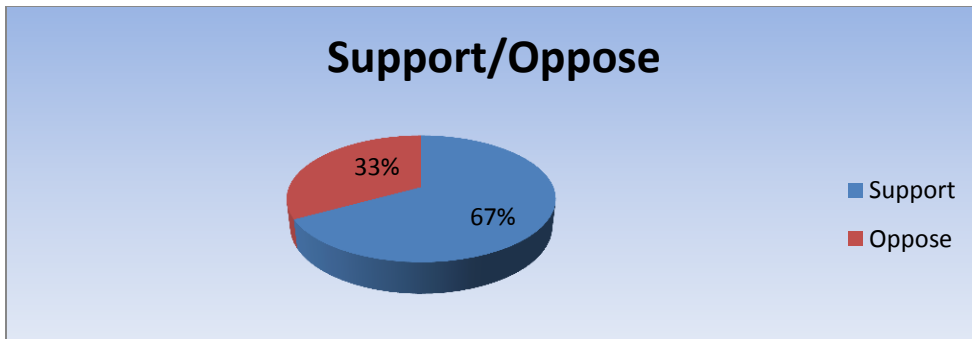
3. Would you support or oppose accelerating state intervention for schools that repeatedly fail annual performance standards?



4. Would you support or oppose removing the lowest 5 percent of ISTEP test scores from official evaluations of teachers and schools?

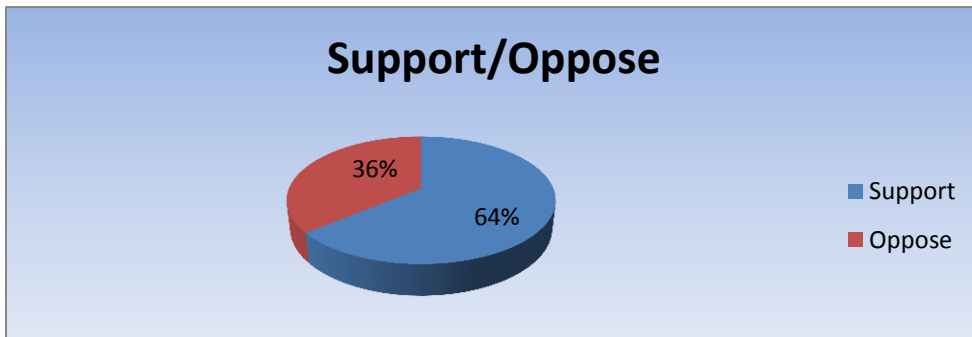


5. Would you support or oppose legislation prohibiting government employees from serving as elected officials for the unit of government that employs them?

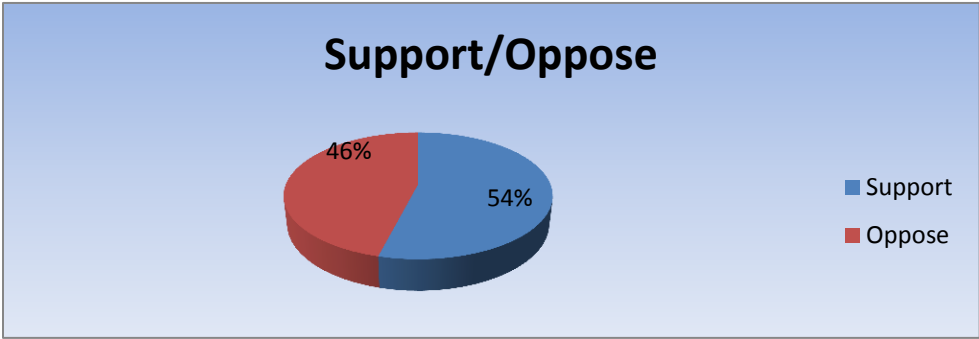

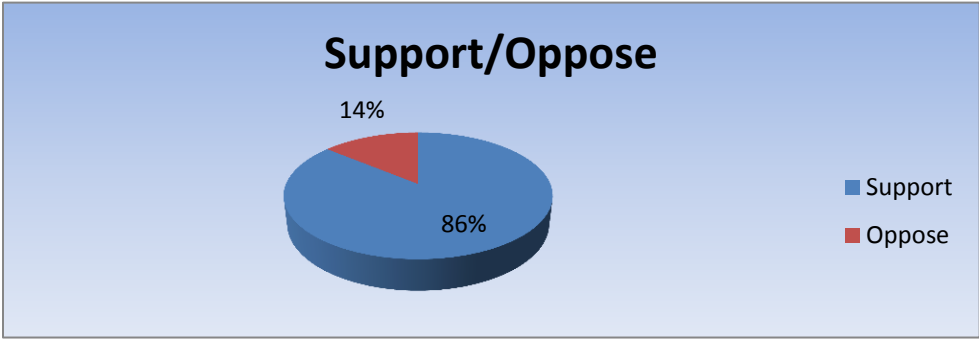
1. If you support prohibiting smoking in public places, would you support or oppose exceptions for bars, private clubs and casinos?



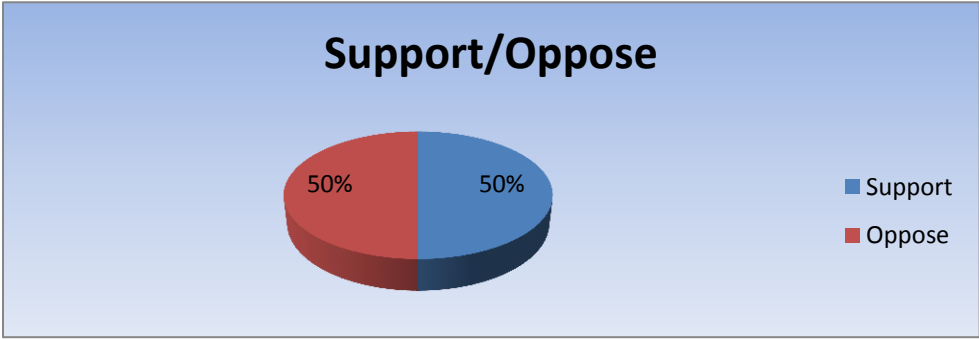
2. Would you support or oppose adding online courses to Indiana’s high-school graduation requirements in an effort to prepare students for college and the 21st-century workforce?



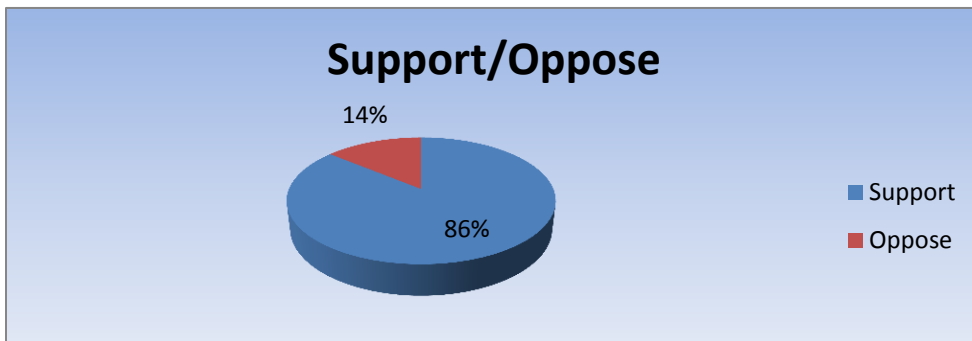
3. Would you support or oppose requiring a public hearing before a school board adopts a new superintendent contract?



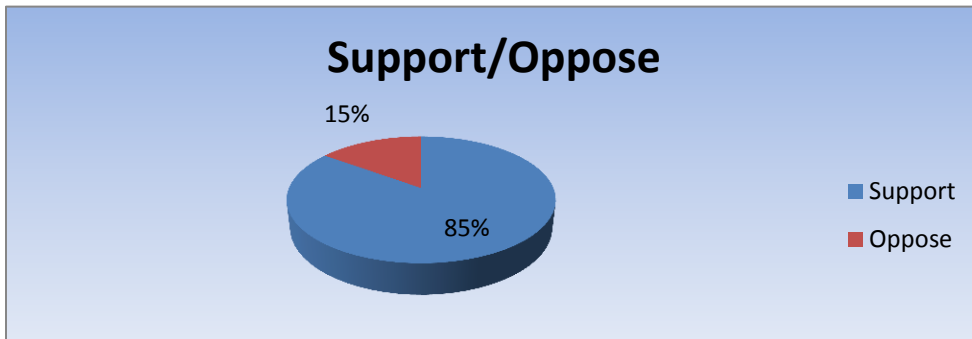
4. Would you support or oppose a study by state officials on the feasibility of offering state purchase preferences to veteran-owned businesses?



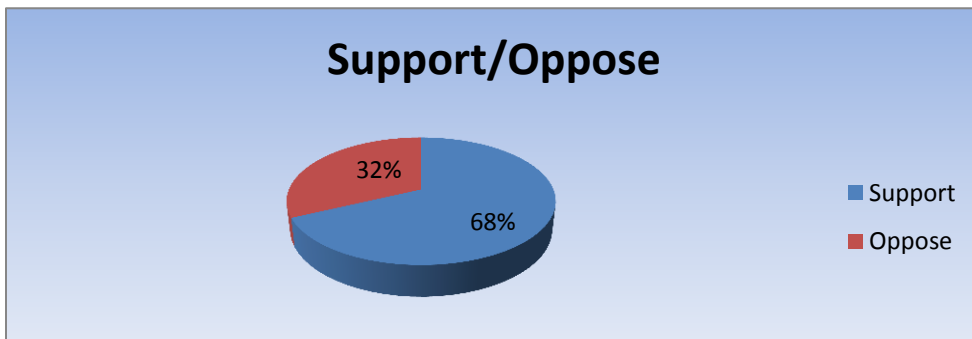
5. Would you support or oppose a law requiring parents and legal guardians to report missing children to authorities?
