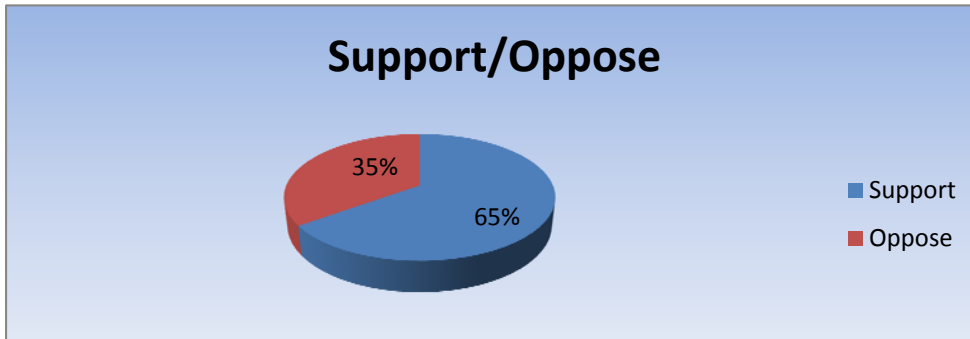


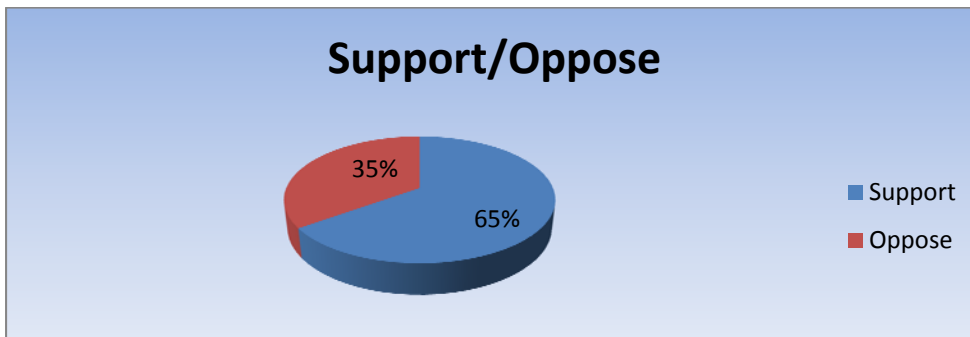

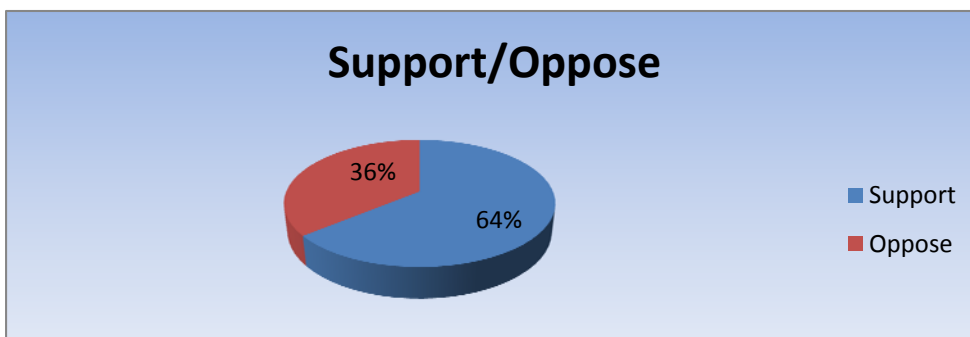
1. Would you support or oppose changing Indiana law to make employee contributions to unions voluntary, rather than mandatory?



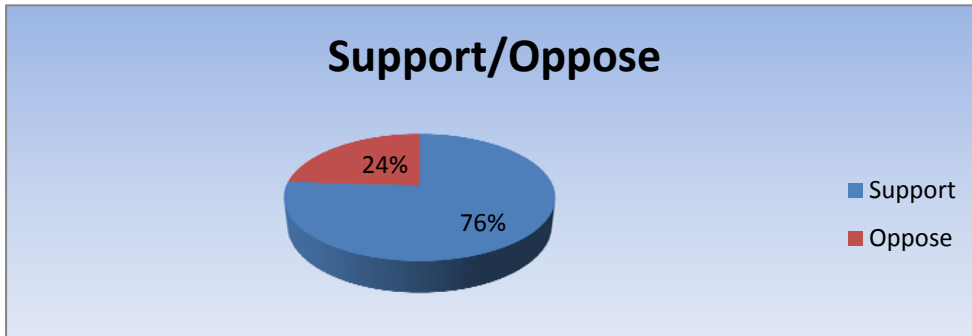

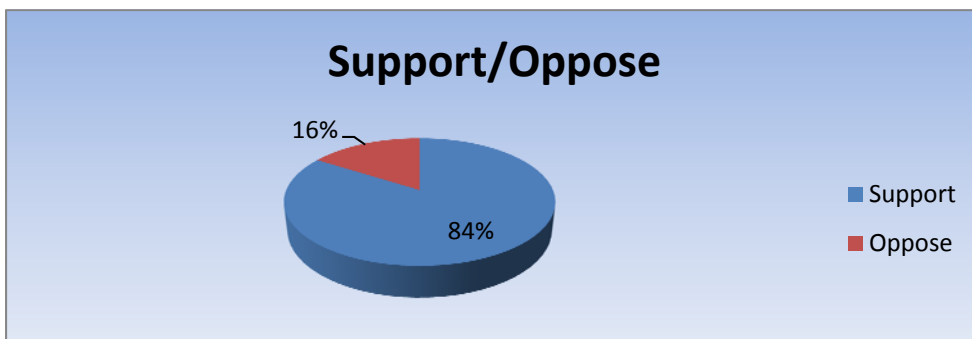
3. Would you support or oppose removing the lowest 5 percent of ISTEP test scores from official evaluations of teachers and schools?



4. Would you support or oppose a law requiring parents and legal guardians to report missing children to authorities?

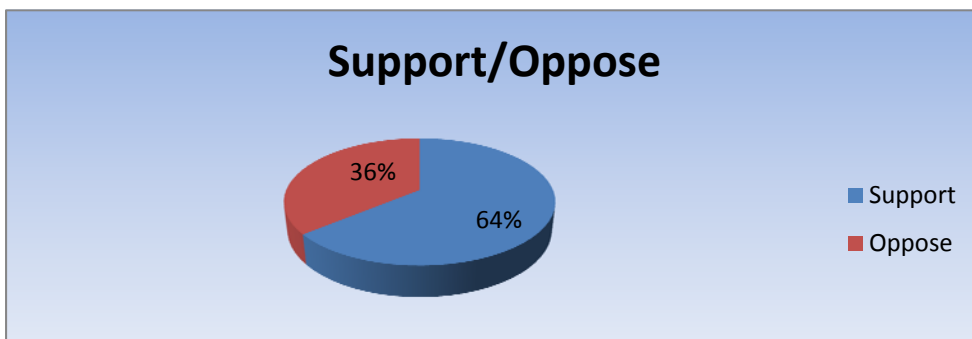


5. Would you support or oppose legislation prohibiting government employees from serving as elected officials for the unit of government that employs them?

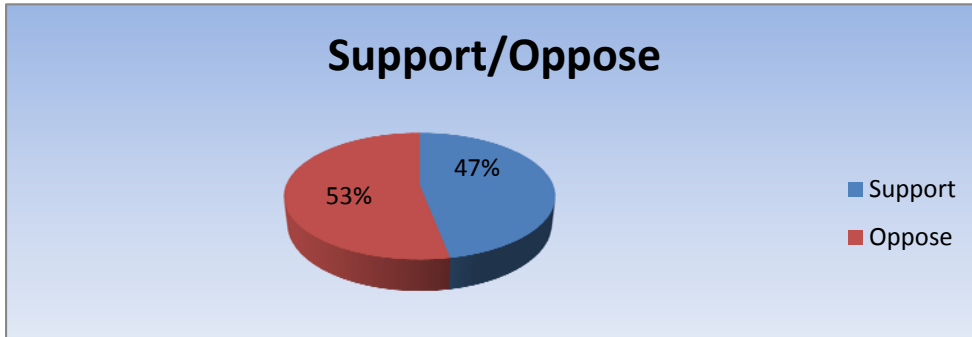

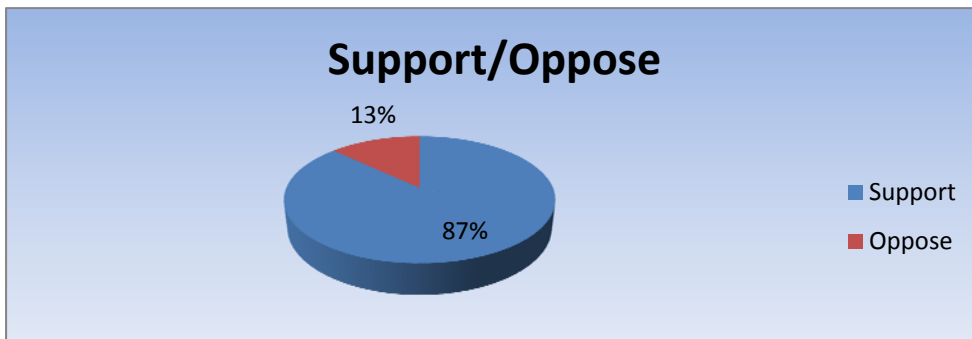
1. Would you support or oppose accelerating state intervention for schools that repeatedly fail annual performance standards?



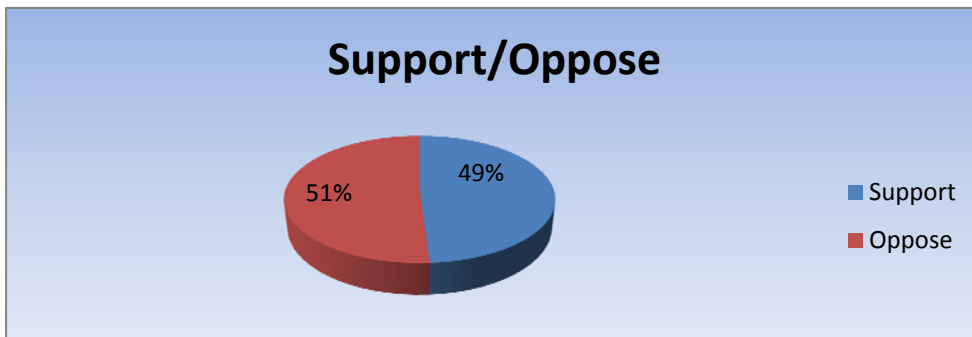
2. Would you support or oppose adding online courses to Indiana’s high-school graduation requirements in an effort to prepare students for college and the 21st-century workforce?
