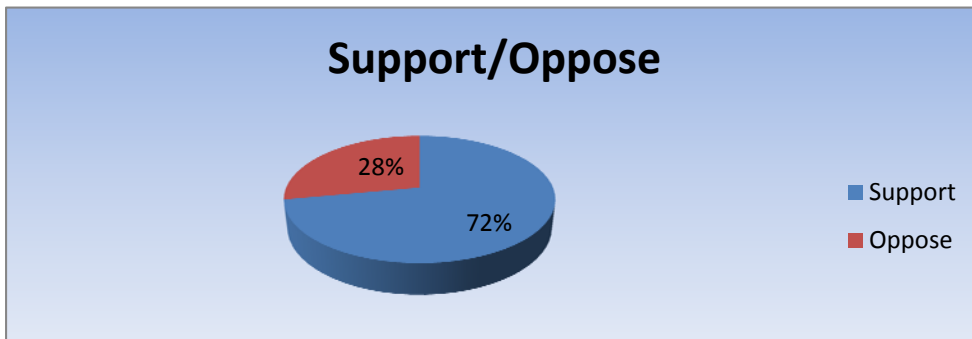


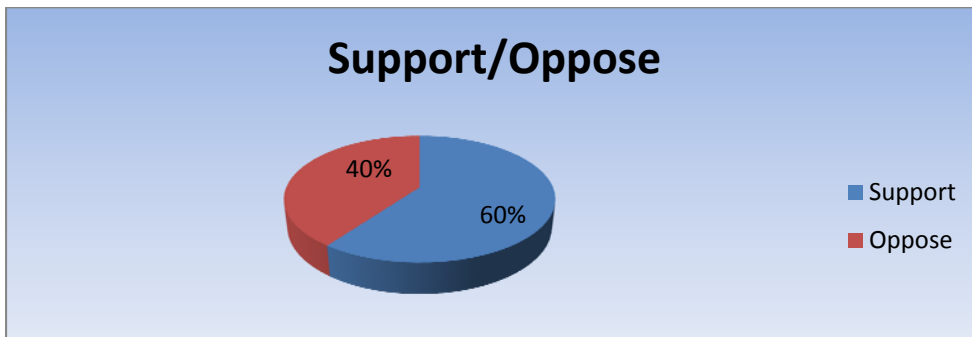
# State Senator Pat Miller's 2012 Legislative Survey Results

## Mailed Survey Results:

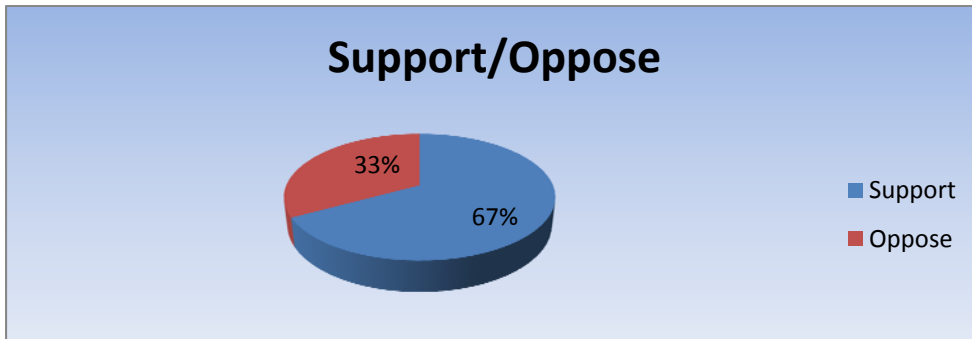

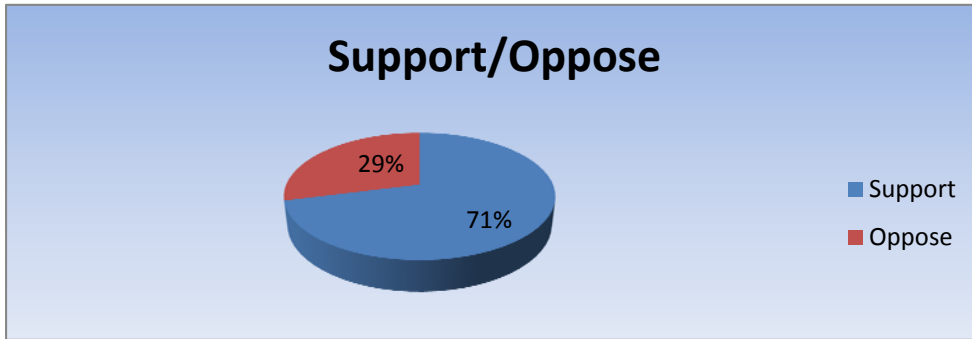
2. Would you support or oppose adding online courses to Indiana's high-school graduation requirements in an effort to prepare students for college and the 21st-century workforce?



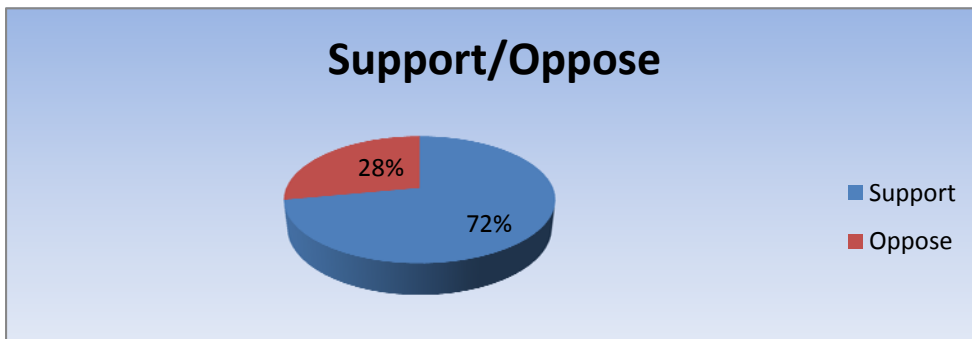
3. Would you support or oppose accelerating state intervention for schools that repeatedly fail annual performance standards?



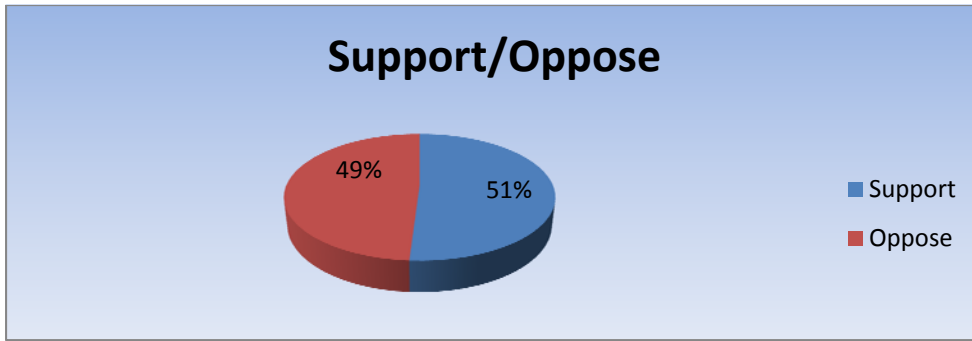
4. Would you support or oppose legislation prohibiting government employees from serving as elected officials for the unit of government that employs them?



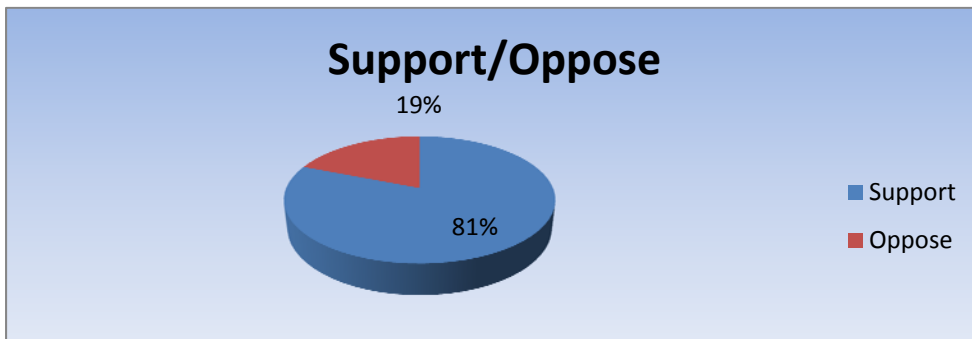
5. Would you support or oppose prohibiting smoking statewide in public places?



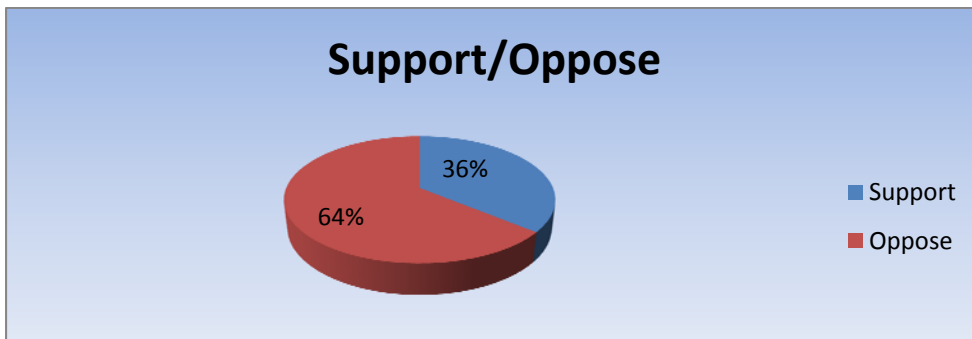
6. If you support prohibiting smoking in public places, would you support or oppose exceptions for bars, private clubs and casinos?
