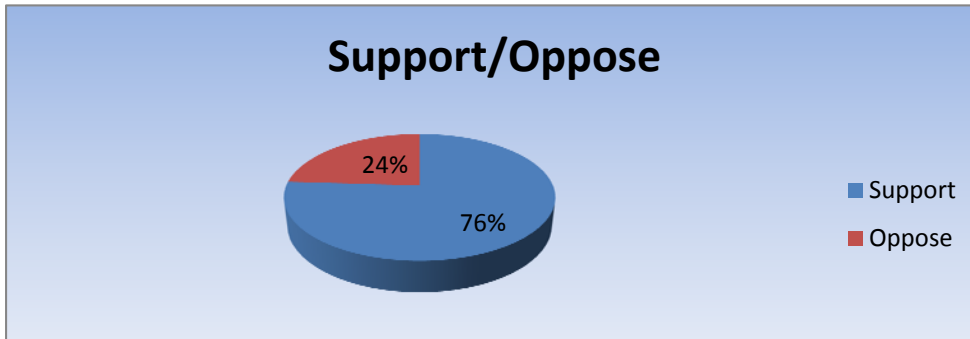


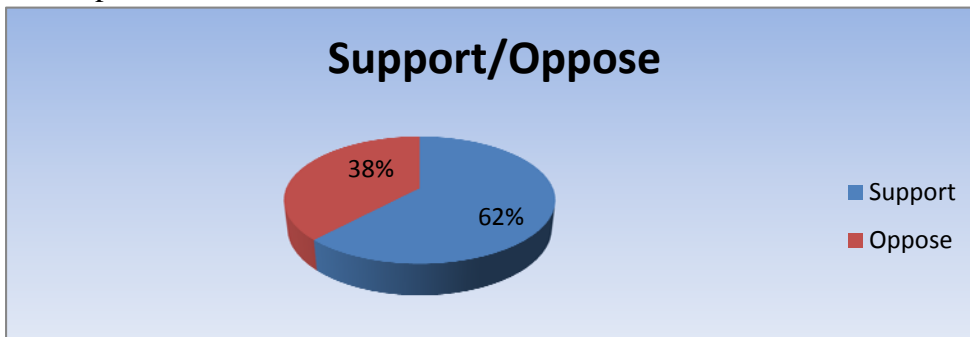
State Senator Ryan Mishler's 2012 Legislative Survey Results

Mailed Survey Results:

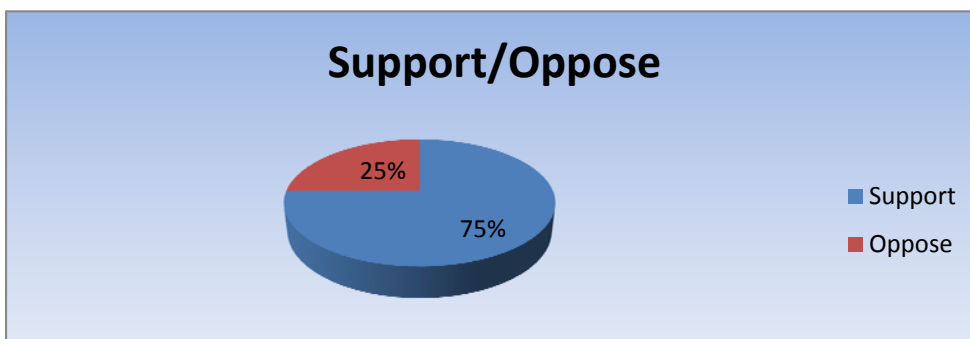
1. Would you support or oppose changing Indiana law to make employee contributions to unions voluntary, rather than mandatory?



2. Would you support or oppose accelerating state intervention for schools that repeatedly fail annual performance standards?

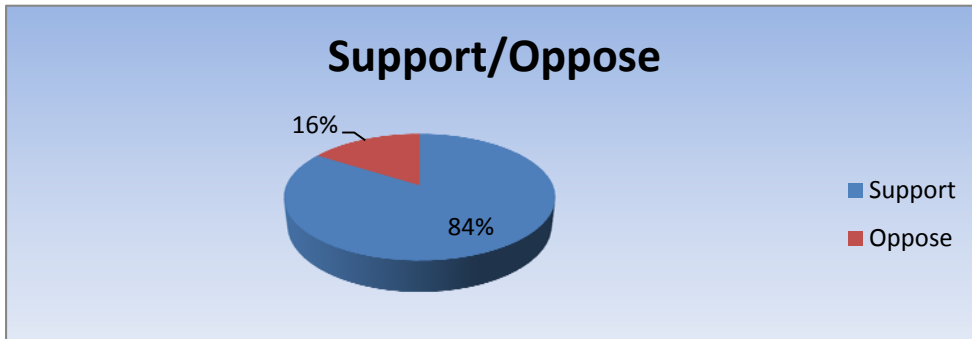


3. Would you support or oppose requiring a public hearing before a school board adopts a new superintendent contract?

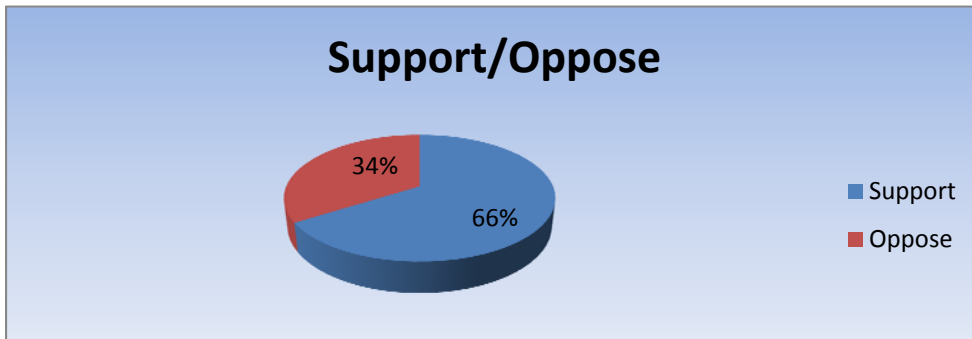


4. Would you support or oppose legislation prohibiting nepotism by local-government employees

to prevent them from serving in a direct supervisory line with family members?

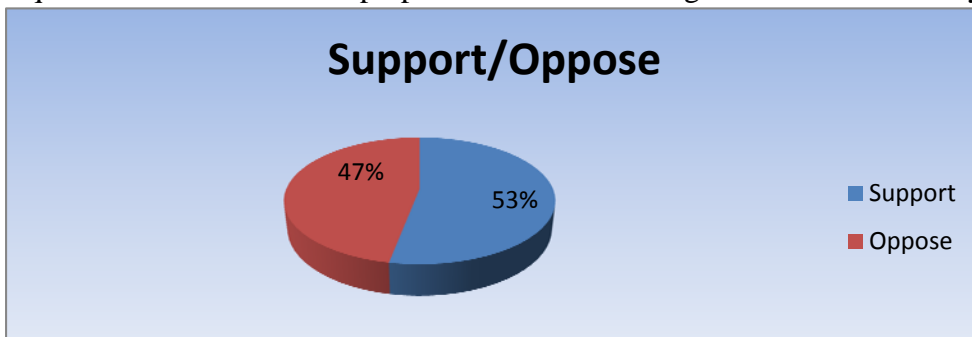


5. Would you support or oppose giving counties the option of transitioning the services of their townships to existing city or county governments?

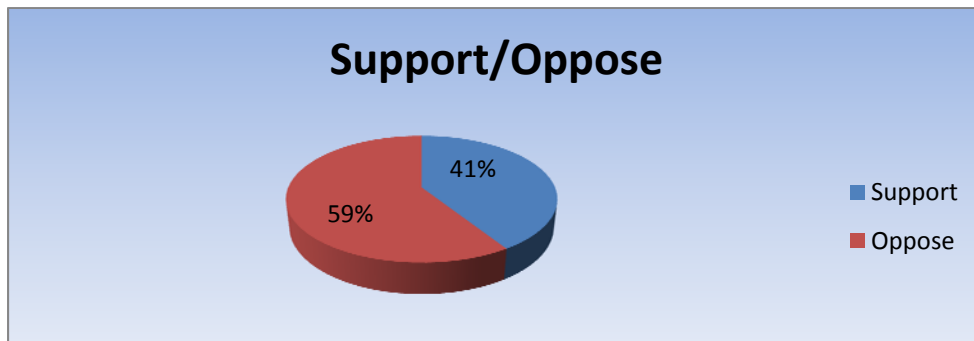


Online Survey Results:
