Emily Duncan serves as the Communications Director for the Office of Indiana Lt. Governor. In her role, she oversees the communications efforts of the five state agencies that make up the family of business including the Indiana State Department of Agriculture (ISDA), the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA), the Indiana Office of Defense Development, the Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA) and the Office of Tourism Development (IOTD).

Prior to joining the Office of the Lt.
