

ELIGIBILITY

Any individual, organization, or company may enter in any appropriate category.

Books considered for this award must have an Indiana theme, or the author must live or have lived in Indiana.

Books must have an ISBN and have been originally published between January 1 and December 31, 2010.

DEADLINES

Entries must be postmarked or delivered in person by **March 31, 2011**.

Finalists will be notified on or after July 31, 2011 (subject to total entry count).

Winners will be announced in August 2011.

JUDGING

A panel of three judges in each category will consider all entries and will grant awards at their discretion.

Entries are judged on the quality of writing, with organization and interpretation also considered.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

No entry fee is required.

Entrants are responsible for all shipping costs - materials sent C.O.D. will be refused.

The judges have the right to change the category of an entry.

2011 ENTRY FORM

One completed entry form must be provided to the Indiana Center for the Book for each title entered. Each entry form must be accompanied by **five (5) non-returnable copies** of the book.
