The classic green Evergreen Indiana card enables users to experience the full benefits of membership, including:

- The ability to browse, place holds and borrow from the collections of over 90 Evergreen libraries statewide.
- Access to the State's largest public library catalogue, which features over 6,000,000 items.
- Full visitor privileges at any Evergreen library throughout Indiana.

The new blue Evergreen Indiana card offers limited library privileges to individuals that use the library, but are not residents of an Evergreen Indiana library district. These individuals include:

- Students—For students attending a college, primary or secondary school in an Evergreen Indiana library district.
- Computer Users—For non-residents who use public computers & other technology resources at the library.
- Reciprocal Borrowers—For patrons of non-Evergreen libraries whose local library has a reciprocal borrowing arrangement with this library.

WHAT ARE LIMITED PRIVILEGES?

Blue card patrons have access to those materials available from the library that issued their blue card and not those of other Evergreen Indiana libraries. However, blue card users still have access to several great Evergreen Indiana features, including:

- Personalized My Account tools and Bookbags that empower patrons to control their renewals, holds, reading lists and more.
- Real-time patron access to late fees & automated overdue reminders.
- Access to the catalogue of the library that issued your blue card with the ability to browse, place holds and borrow from that collection.
