Minutes

The minutes from the September 13th meeting were approved with two grammatical corrections.

INCOLSA Report

Trace reported that in 2007 there have been 7.5 million downloads, 11.8 million logins, and 21 million searches. He also added that since the INSPIRE launched in 1998 there have been 100 million searches and that 1 in 3 searches result in a full text article being viewed. Lewis asked if the EBSCO Premier stats were included and Trace reported that they were included since June when Premier was added. Bowell asked for Premier specific stats and Trace responded that he would send a spreadsheet that details database use by individual database title.

State Library Update

Speer reported that ISLAC has approved LSTA funds for the operations of INSPIRE and for the purchase of databases. The ILHB will be presented with the recommendation at their December 14th meeting. Speer said that a selection committee is reviewing and evaluating the responses to the RFP for the operations of the databases. A decision on the new vendor should be made soon and a contract should be in place in January. Lewis asked about the name of the databases and Corridan stated that the name is not resolved but if an agreement can not be reached INQUIRE will be the new name. Corridan also stated that there are plans to have users test the new interface.

Strategic Plan

Hettlinger presented an updated marketing and training section of the strategic plan. Hettlinger and Elaine Skopelja have revised the section. The committee discussed the goals and actions and made additional recommendations. Hettlinger said that she would incorporate the updates and e-mail the committee the changes.
