## Biographical Note

---

William Carter, born December 15, 1812, married Betsy, and they had two daughters, Emma and Florence and a son, William. He lived in Columbus, Ohio in 1868; Defiance, Ohio in 1869. He was addressed as the Hon. Wm. Carter and as William Carter, Esq., so he was probably a lawyer and perhaps a judge. He died January 29, 1881 and is buried in Riverside Cemetery, Defiance, Ohio. ## Biographical Note

---

William Carter, born to William and Elizabeth [Betsy] Dugget Carter in Defiance Ohio, January 31, 1857, was also a lawyer. In the 1890s, he was the Secretary of the committee planning the centennial of Gen. Anthony Wayne's arrival at Fort Defiance in Ohio. He wrote a book, *Fort Defiance Centennial*, in 1894. He lived in Indianapolis in the early 1900s and wrote to his mother.
