Biographical Note:

Eliza Ketcham was born in 1825 and married Mr. Henson, who was born in 1817. Three census takers recorded his first name in three different ways: Zimei, Zemri, and Zunir. In 1850, they had one child, Margaret J., who was eight years old. In 1880, Margaret was 39, living with her husband Samuel Davis, age 37, and her mother Eliza A. Henson, a widow, age 55, in Orangeville, Orange County, Indiana.

John Mitchell was the great-grandfather of Eva Emery Doty.

Scope and Content:

The first folder contains Eliza A. Ketcham's 1837 copy books which she created while a student at the Monroe County Female Institute in Bloomington. She has quotations by famous authors and verses from the Bible. Eliza copied a full page of the same sentence with the first letter of each sentence being a letter of the alphabet. There are two sets of these penmanship worksheets.

Some of the other photocopies are about the school band, poems, stories, jokes, and riddles.

The second folder has a 1922 advertisement for a 100th anniversary of Indiana University, with a picture of the first college building. There is a list of John Mitchell's personal property. He lived from 1809 to 1896, and divided his property among his sons. There are photocopies of old money and a land grant from President James Monroe.
