# Apply.

Applying is easy! Submit an essay with the following information:

- Describe how your organization is active in your community
- Describe the strengths and challenges of your community
- Your vision for your community
- How does this vision impact your decision on returning to your hometown?
- Provide your community's demographics, population, major employers, the percentage of homeowners and renters, and other information that supports your vision

The following documents are not required, but applications that include any or all of these will be given preference:

- A letter of support from the Mayor, Town Council President, or highest elected official showing support for your application. The letter should tell how the community is willing to be involved and support the creation and utilization of the Community Vision Plan if you are selected
- A letter of support from your community's State Representative
- A letter of support from your community's State Senator
- Images such as maps, pictures, drawings, or other examples of your plan, potential future projects, and community elements
- Letters of support from other community partners who support your vision

## Other Information.

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee. Up to five (5) applications will be chosen, to work on community vision plans and will receive a \$500 award for their chapter or organization. Leadership-based organizations that are chosen to work on the Community Vision Plan will work closely for several months with IHCD, the BSU team, and members and officials of their community to create the plan.
